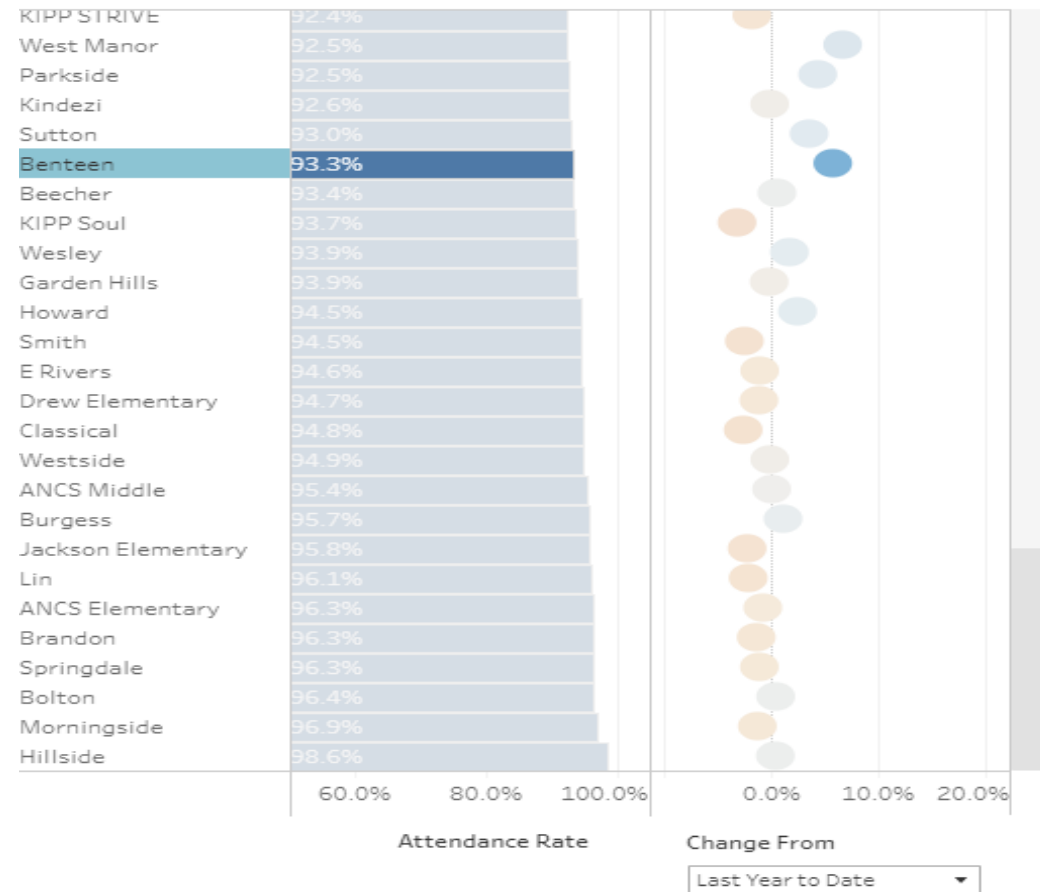

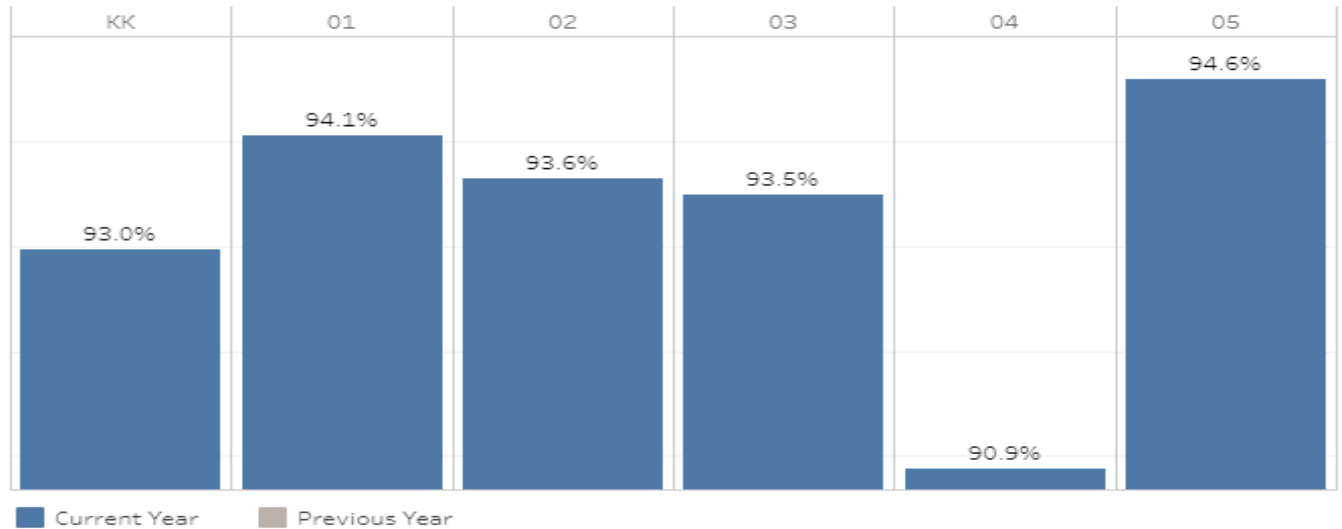

SY2021-2022 ADA Attendance Rate: **89.3%**

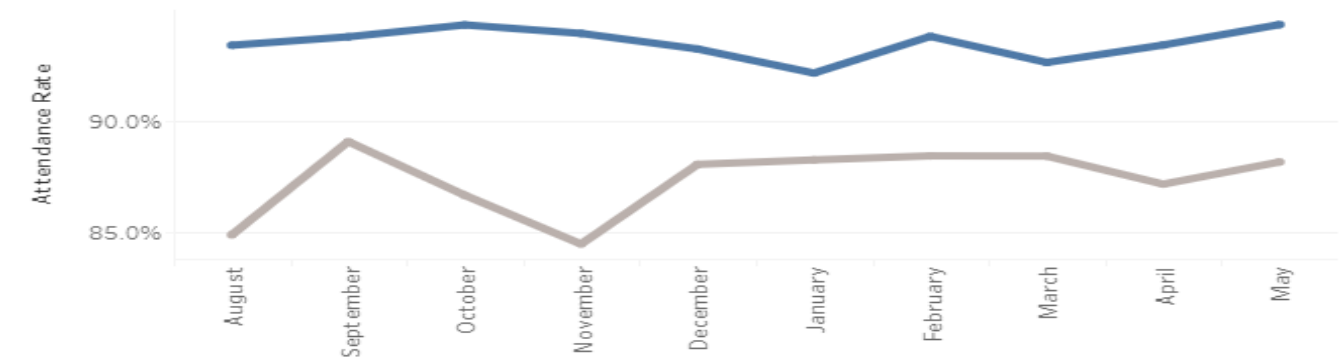
District ADA Attendance Comparison SY2021-2022
