Leveling is the process the District uses to adjust school budget allocations to match student enrollment.

\$48,006 (change based on increase) Budget Adjustment (+\$131,971)\* ##Crease) \$31,126 (leveling reserve) \$7,828 (Title Ladjustmen \$7,838 (Title I adjustment) \$45,000 (Security Grant)
