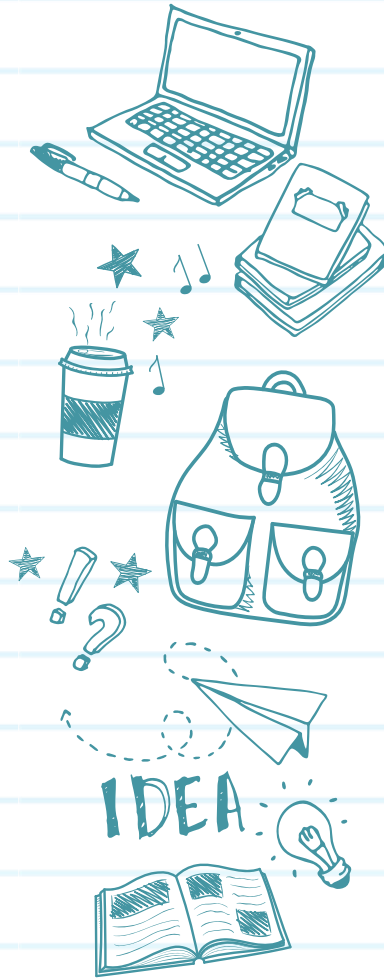

# Needs Assessment: Guiding Questions

- What does this data tell us? -Have made gains in reading and math. Increased developing learners by small percentages. The district regressed as a whole in math.
- What good news is there to celebrate?-We are moving the needle in reading. Reduce beginning readers. Increase percentage in beginning and developing over 10%.
- Where are growth opportunities?- reduce number of beginning math learners. Move Proficient to distinguished.
- What trends do we see in the data?- We are growing children. We see growth. We are 5th in the district in math for growth. It's slow and steady but there is growth.
