 - i. Continuous Improvement Plan and Strategic Plan Alignment: Reviewed the data analysis protocol synthesis responses
 - Strengths: 47% of 2nd students exceeded their Spring Map Growth reading Target; 2nd grade and 4th grade MAP Growth Reading is





high average to high; MTSS process reached exemplar based on EOY review

- Challenges: % students decreased by 1.4% in proficient and above based on the MATH GMAS for 3-5 math; % of students decreased by 6.4% in developing and above based in the MATH GMAS for grades 3-5 math; ELA minimal increase in all grades except 2nd grade ELA; % of students decreased by 15.1% in proficient and above based on the Science GMASfor grades 3-5 math
- ii. Strategic Plan Update
 - Reviewed the current Strategic Plan 2021-2025 (Smart Goals, APS Strategic Priorities and Initiatives, School Strategic Priorities, and School Strategies) What do you notice? What are your wonderings? What additional questions do you have?
 - As a team we came up with the following goals:
 - ADA at 95% in the strategic plan but not in the CIP
 - Adding a science goal for 5 grade science
 - Set a goal or indicators for effectiveness of the new teacher induction program.
- MAP Data: Spring 2023 to Fall 2023
 Reviewed the data results and goals:
 - Increase the % of grades 3-5 students scoring proficient or above in reading from 10% to 25% as measured by the Georgia Milestone Assessment by Spring 2025.
 - Increase the % of grades 3-5 students scoring proficient or above in math from 11% to 25% as measured by the Georgia Milestone Assessment by Spring 2025.
 - 85% of students reach their growth target in reading and math as measured by the MAP Growth Reading and Math Assessment by Spring 2025.
 - Increase the weekly attendance rate for K-5 students to an average of 95% by Spring 2025.
