The percentage of students in grades 3-5 scoring proficient or above in Reading/ELA will increase from 12% to 15% and decrease the percentage of students scoring beginning from 58% to 55% on the 2024 GMAS.

The percentage of students in grades 3-5 scoring proficient or above in Math will increase from 10% to 13% and decrease the percentage of students scoring beginning from 61% to 58% on the 2024 GMAS.

The percentage of students meeting the CCRPI criteria will increase from 61.8% to 64% and the average daily attendance rate (ADA) will increase from 91% to 93%.



Q: Why are students still marked absent with an excuse?


