IV. Discussion Items

a. FY21 Budget Update

Principal Taylor discussed with the GO TEAM the school's budget reduction due to COVID 19. Our proposed budget was \$5,915, 522. Our new budget is \$5,828,001. This gives our school a reduction of \$87,551. We need to find \$87,551 to help offset the budget. Principal Taylor discussed with the GO Team the items that would be decreased to accommodate for the loss of funds. These items were staff development, employee and admin travel for conferences, and contracted services, to name a few. The CARES Act would help tremendously with technology replacement and items needed for the school due to the COVID 19 Protective measures issued by the CDC.

There will be Awards Ceremonies taking place in Zoom. The parents and students will be able to see their awards earned for the school year during our Virtual Awards Day. Fifth grade's Virtual Awards Day will be a more elaborate. Fifth grade will also have a Virtual Transition Meeting through Sylvan on May 15. On the last day of school Friday, May 22, 2020 the staff will participate in a Drive-thru Parade. The staff will drive through the neighborhoods that Finch services to send a Farwell to our fifth-grade students and show love and support to all other grade levels. Additionally, the staff will celebrate Ms. Ericka White by giving her



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best wishes in her future endeavor next school year. She will be going into a different profession and will not be returning to Finch.
