#### IV. Discussion Items

#### a. Winter Universal Screener Review

Mr. Johnson discussed with the TEAM the result from the Winter assessment. In comparing our Fall Map Data to our Winter Map Data for 3<sup>rd</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> grade, we saw a decrease from 17% to 14% in reading. The 3% decrease equates to about 1 student. Similarly in math, we increased by 4-5% (1 student). Mr. Johnson emphasized that the data has stabilized, which is positive considering the learning loss due to the pandemic. One of the highlights mentioned by Mr. Johnson is that the reading assessment showed 6% of students moved out of the beginner learner stage, which equates to 2-3 students. These students increased their level of proficiency. Additionally, Mr. Johnson compared the baseline data received from the Fall Assessment at the beginning of the year to the typical growth for the middle of the year showed by the Winter Assessment. Here is our growth in reading for grades 3-5: 3rd grade 45% growth, 4th grade 47% growth, and 5th grade 73% growth. Here is our growth in math for grades 3-5: 3rd grade 54% growth, 4th grade 58% growth, and 5th grade 44% growth.

## b. **Initial Budget Presentation**

Mr. Johnson explained the budget process to the team and wants to ensure that we help design a budget that will hire the right people. Also, he wants the Go Team to focus on the big picture and ensure that the budget aligns to key strategic priorities. Our proposed budget is 5,823,032 for the FY23. Our school is projected to lose 43 students in the upcoming school year and that has had an impact on the budget. Mr. Johnson also mentioned that we can use the CARES funding from the Covid-19 for other school-approved funding and that he will



share with the GO Team once he has it. He shared our timeline for the budget season. January is the Initial Budget information for the GO Team. Then, February will include a more detailed budget and will allow for feedback from the GO Team about the budget. Last, March is when the GO Team must approve the budget.
