




Students should be able to express themselves through their clothing. Some people want to show personality.






TOOMER'S OPTIONAL UNIFORM POLICY SURVEY RESULTS

OF PARTICIPANTS





- Remove collared shirts as a requirement.


DO YOU UNDERSTAND THE CURRENT OPTIONAL UNIFORM POLICY?

- Suggestions to make a firm decision. Either a yes or no to uniforms and not make it optional.


IS THE SCHOOL'S OPTIONAL UNIFORM POLICY MESSAGING CLEAR?

- No enforcement and it is confusing parent on whether not they should follow the policy or not


ARE YOU OPPOSED TO THE OPTIONAL UNIFORM POLICY?


