- Our 2019-2020 STEM Theme is focused on building an inclusive and diverse community BeltLine for a secure, affordable, and healthy environment one Application at a time
  - Our 6<sup>th</sup> through 8<sup>th</sup> grade math and science teachers are collaboratively planning our first STEM unit for the semester...
    - The 6<sup>th</sup> grade team will focus on the sources of water runoff in connection to the construction and revitalization of the West End community
    - The 7<sup>th</sup> grade team will focus on the interruption of our ecosystems and habitats due to the BeltLine additions
    - The 8<sup>th</sup> grade team will focus on providing solar panel energy after hours along the BeltLine
- The 2019-2020 STEM Innovation Program Enrollment Forms were distributed to our 6<sup>th</sup> through 8<sup>th</sup> grade cohort students during the September 18<sup>th</sup>, 2019 Curriculum Night. The deadline for enrollment form submission is October 4<sup>th</sup>, 2019.
- ➤ During the month of September, STEM cohort students participated in the Washington Cluster STEAM Day on September 25<sup>th</sup>, hosted by the Mercedes Benz Stadium and the Southern Company. Approximately 93 students attended this event.
- This semester (Fall 2019), we've started the following clubs:
  - Robotics Club, offered during the Afterschool Allstars
  - Stimulate STEM 100 Program for girls, offered bi-monthly during the advisement period and hosted by NCBW 100
  - Boys STEM Club, offered bi-monthly beginning October 16<sup>th</sup> during the advisement period focused on Audio Engineering
- ➤ We also have 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> grade students participating in the following Georgia Tech's CEISMC programs:
  - o 6<sup>th</sup> grade: GoSTEAM water conservation PBL unit (October 2019 May 2020)
  - o 7<sup>th</sup> grade: Honeywell STEM Challenge (September 2019- December 2019)
