 - B. ACES Review
 - An opportunity to discuss data with the district.
 - 2 Current staffing vacancies
 - Projected Enrollment: 762
 - Student population:
 - English learners: 6.7% = 53 Students
 - Students with disabilities: 17.7%= 140 students
 - **Gifted: 10:6% = 83 Students**
 - Attendance Take Rate = 85.1%
 - Average Daily Attendance Rate= 87.4%
 - Students not chronically absent= 49.6%
 - Low attendance rate is due to teacher absences this school year.
 - NWEA MAO Assessments results show that students grew tremendously, however, not many have grown out of their initial placement. (ie: grown from beginner to developing).
 - Connection teachers will support Math and ELA teachers while Social Studies and Science teachers will teach their content through the lens of Math and ELA.
 - To accomplish a successful SY22, teachers need additional incentives to boost daily attendance and overall well-being.
