#### IV. Discussion Items

- a. **Discussion Item 1:** King's Strategic Plan
  - The King Leadership Team met on more than one occasion to discuss and give their input.
  - Includes implementing over 50 hours of Interdisciplinary units.
  - Connection teachers implementing ATL skills.
  - Implementing the Learner Profile Report Card
  - Key performance measures disclaimer: Due to the virtual learning environment caused by the pandemic, 2019 data will be used as the benchmark.
  - Includes only full academic year students. Students present 65% of the time.
  - Utilizing full time instructional coach in all content areas.
  - Using virtual platforms on a wider scale (e.g., For example: reaching parents who cannot attend meetings or students who cannot stay afterschool)
  - Enroll at least 50 students into the Young King & Queens program.
  - Enroll 120 students into the after school all-stars program.

#### b. Principals Report - Budget

- FY2022 Budget is \$8,710,404; \$4,445 per student.
- Budget has been adjusted due to the decrease of 22 students.
- King was projected to have 253 students attend the 1<sup>st</sup> day of in-person learning but only 112 students showed up.
- Found the 1<sup>st</sup> week of in-person & Virtual learning to be successful.
