 - i. In the final budget meeting of the school year, Ms. Gibbs presented the final budget recommendations for approval. The team discussed the allocation of funds, with a focus on strengthening teachers' capacity and aligning with the school's strategic plan. A key change was the addition of a building sub, funded by the district, to support emergency teacher coverage. The team also discussed the use of funds for instructional planning, professional development, and web-based subscriptions. The budget was voted on and approved, with a focus on instruction and the addition of a master teacher for writing.
