



• The projected enrollment for Sylvan Hills Middle was 570 students. As of the 15th day of school (August 21, 2018), Infinite Campus reflects that the actual enrollment for Sylvan Hills Middle was 555 students. Since Sylvan Hills Middle was below projected enrollment by 15 students, an reduction of \$65,088 is required (at the SSF base per pupil amount of \$4,339).



SYLVAN HILLS BUDGET

Title I Funds:

• Because the district's Title I allocation is higher than originally anticipated, all Title I schools are being adjusted. Sylvan Hills Middle has been allocated an additional \$43,875 in Title I funds.

General Fund Carryover:

This year, schools can carry over 25% of the total amount remaining on non-salary line items from FY2018. The amount carried over for Sylvan Hills Middle school is \$1,971.
