## IV. Discussion Items

- a. **Discussion Item 1: Spring MAP results**
  - i. Compared to last year, we have gained points for Proficient and above.
  - ii. For Math we have 22% that are Proficient and above in all grade levels.
    - 1. SWD – 6<sup>th</sup> graders have reduced our Beginning level by 10% over the past years.
    - 2. ESOL - 6<sup>th</sup> Graders have also reduced our Beginning level by more than 10% over the past years.
    - 3. Comparing our Winter to Spring MAP, we are 4 points away from meeting our targets for all grade levels for Proficient and above and Distinguished.
  - iii. For ELA, our Beginning level has decreased which then increased our Developing and Proficient level achievement.
    - 1. The 6<sup>th</sup> graders from this year are performing better than the sixth graders from last year.
    - 2. SWD – We reduced from 84% to 64% for achievement.
    - 3. ESOL – Our students' achievement at the Distinguished level has doubled from last year.
    - 4. Comparing our Winter to Spring MAP, we are hitting all targets for all grade levels except 7th grade Distinguished achievement.
  - iv. For 8<sup>th</sup> grade Science, we improved by 6% for our Beginning level students and are meeting our targets for all achievement levels.

  - i. We are looking at our data to identify 2-3 potential needs for the next school year.
  - ii. The data is telling us that we are moving in the right direction. We need to ensure we follow the instructional coaches' guidance to continue the trajectory. We want to target our Subgroups with SDI instruction to meet their needs and continue their growth.
    - 1. Needs:
      - a. All teachers trained in SDI instruction for subgroups – PD for all teachers. All teachers trained properly in pedagogy and content so that we will remain in a positive trajectory.
      - b. Ensure that we have the resources for SDI instruction and intervention.

- c. Rigorous and challenging enrichment instruction for Gifted students with connections to the real-world. Emphasis on increasing the number of Gifted certified teachers to enhance Gifted instruction.
