IV. Discussion Items

A. **Discussion Item 1**: Presentation of the final budget

- We began with Step 7, which is Approval of the Budget for EC. The topics of discussion were the Staffing Conference with the Associate Superintendent and Key Leads for Review. Members reviewed and discussed the Parameters of the Budget's rationale and funding allocations regarding the Priorities, APS-5, Strategies which would benefit Family Engagement, Title I, Stem Program, Freshman Orientation, the Kings of Carver to name a few. Also, discussion positions must be cut due to low projected enrollment [525]. Suggestions were made of ways to increase enrollment. TSI money was mentioned and how those funds would be used for support paraprofessional, resources, etc.
- B. Discussion Item 2: Security Grant Survey

Go Team Members participated in a discussion and survey of what would be the top three (3) in our efforts to use funds of \$45K from GADOE to enhance school security. After discussion we concluded as such—(1) Fencing/Gates, (2) Outside Camaras, and (3) ID Badge Systems, which may require and additional security position.

C. Discussion Item 3: Winter Milestones Data

Seeking to improve data results from 31% Developing , 35% Proficient so as to meet the CCRPI expectations. Additionally, we had a 100% passing rate for our only American Literature class taught on campus by Ms. West Jones. However, due to the American Disability Act [ADA] our results overall in American Lit was at 94%. The students who take the class online who fall under ADA scored below passing and with their home school being Carver EC, it calculated into our data results. With that being said, we anticipate passing with Proficient and Distinguish in American Lit, US History, Biology, etc.

D. Discussion 4. Uniforms and Dress Code

Because we are a campus with two (2) schools-- EC & STEAM, students will be required to wear uniforms: Carver EC Paraphernalia. It is a necessity for safety precautions; full compliance is the goal. Students in compliance will receive positive through an incentive plan. A panel of parents and students has been created to redefine a new style of unforms for the Y24-25. A Fashion was suggested to showoff the new uniforms once selected. The big task is to get Parent and Student Buy in with the new look.
