1.	 School Budget Process and Timeline – The team reviewed the schedule for review and approval of the school's FY2018 budget: Thurs, 1/12 – Dr. Bockman receives allocations from APS. Thurs, 1/19 @ 4pm (time tentative) – Go Team meets to review and provide feedback on draft budget. Open to public. Mon, 1/30 @ 4pm (time tentative) – Go Team meets to approve final school budget. Open to the public. 	Ongoing
2.	Principal Selection Process Update – APS will hold community meetings with staff, students, and parents on Tuesday, January 10 to develop a leadership profile. Go Team will interview a final pool of candidates, likely scheduled in early February.	No action needed
3.	School-Based Solutions (SBS) Process – The Go Team briefly discussed the process for applying for SBS waivers. Principal would develop a proposal and submit it to APS after Go Team approval. Cluster principals are currently discussing options for SBS based on cluster plan. There is no particular deadline and is a rolling process.	Ongoing
4.	Review of first semester grade data – Dr. Bockman provided a high level review of the grades from first semester, broken down by student subgroup. The Go Team discussed the current grading policy including implications of the "Incomplete (I)" and how the school is providing remediation to students with grades below 70. The team requested a breakdown of the data by department, which will be provided. Damiani suggested the school look at providing the math and writing workshops (currently afterschool) during Advisement to provide during school remediation. Dr. Bockman will investigate this to start in February.	No action needed
