1.	 Facilities Update – Current Needs (including maintenance): Dr. Bockman provided an spreadsheet of facilities maintenance issues updated on April 17. There continue to be several open issues that pose safety concerns. APS officials, led by Mr. Hoskins, will review this directly with Bockman and other facilities personnel to address items, as budget permits. An APS team has been out to assess the theatre to create a proposal for upgrades. APS is expected to front these costs to be completed this summer ahead of the full campus renovation. APS is awaiting a final proposal and will then make final decisions. 	Active
