a. **Discussion Item 1**: Ms. Tanner and Dr. Bockman discussed the current school Strategic Plan and review process. Various aspects of the Continuous Improvement Plan (CIP) were reviewed, including needs assessment and SMART goals, as detailed in the presentation

b. **Discussion Item 2**:

i. Phoebe Fung presented Spring 2023 MAP Results. There were some instances of improvement. Significant achievement gaps among subgroups persist. Parental navigators and student mentors were suggested to increase engagement, which improves student achievement. Teachers are working to highlight the importance of MAP for 9th/10th graders. The school has changed its mastery assessment approach to focus more on in-class work versus homework.

a. **Principal's Report**

i. Current enrollment is 1625 versus projections of 1676. However, no funds were lost due to levelling up. In addressing capacity, there has been some discussion about having students do off-campus learning.
