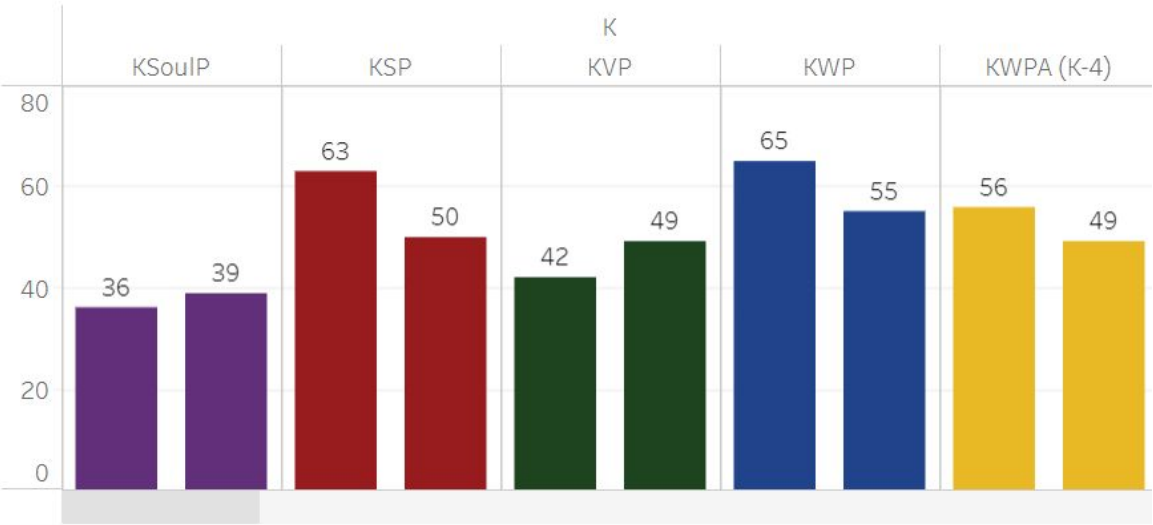

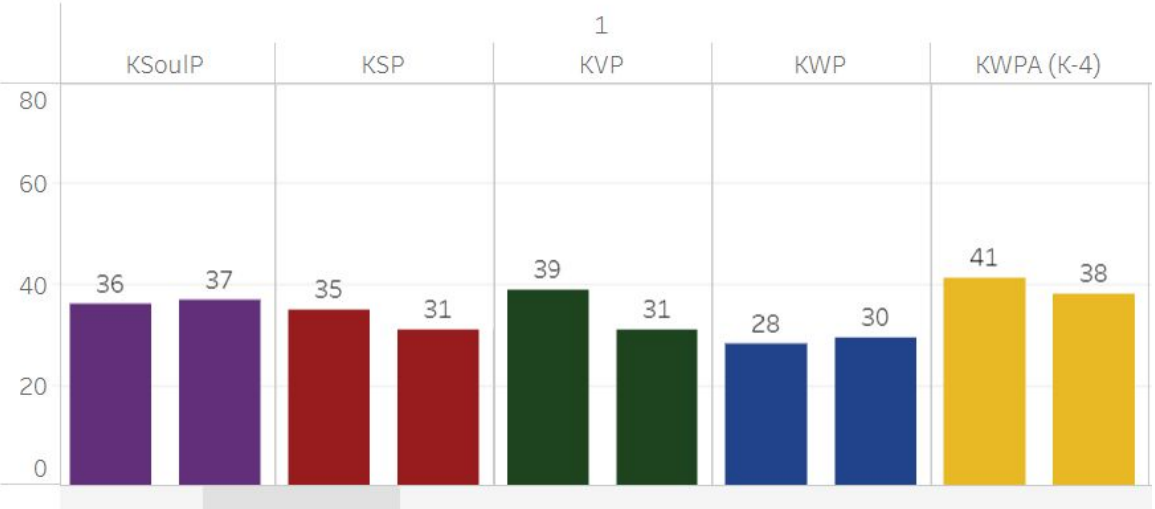

Median Math SGP by Grade/School

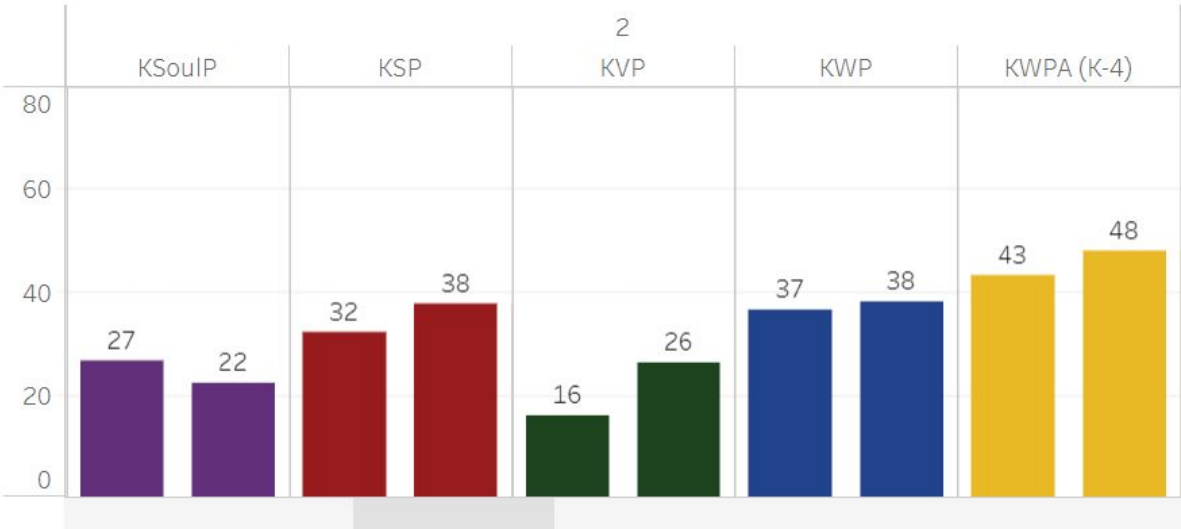

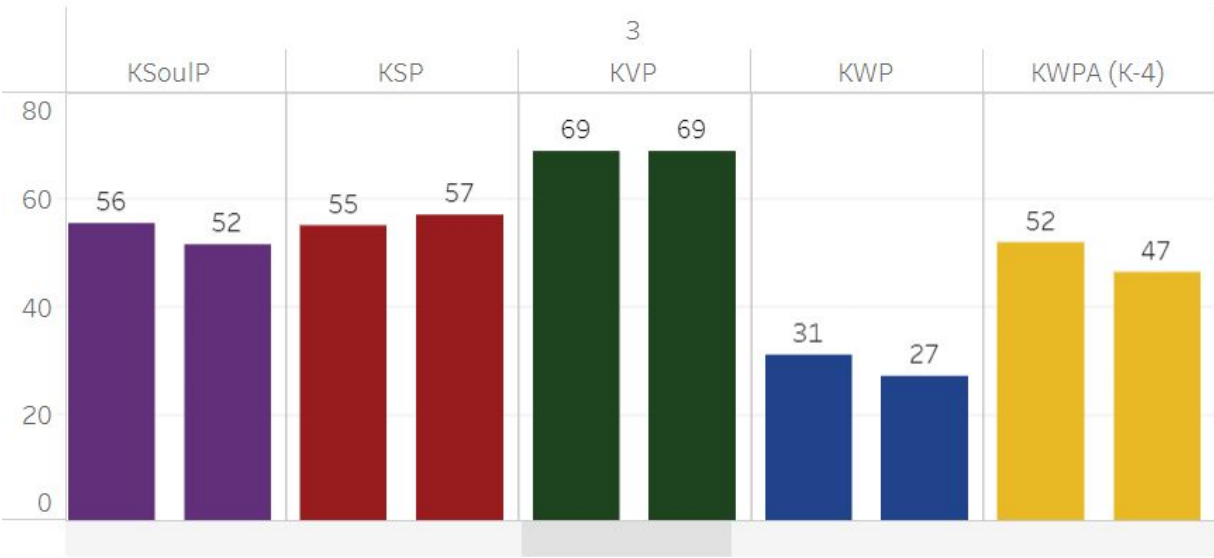


EOY MAP Math Comparative Data: 2 & 3 Growth

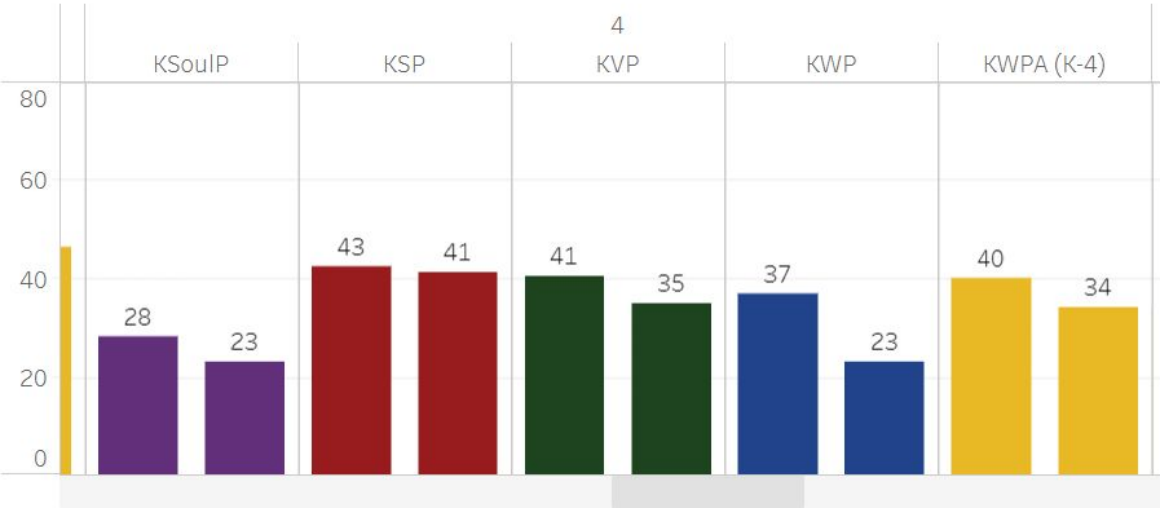

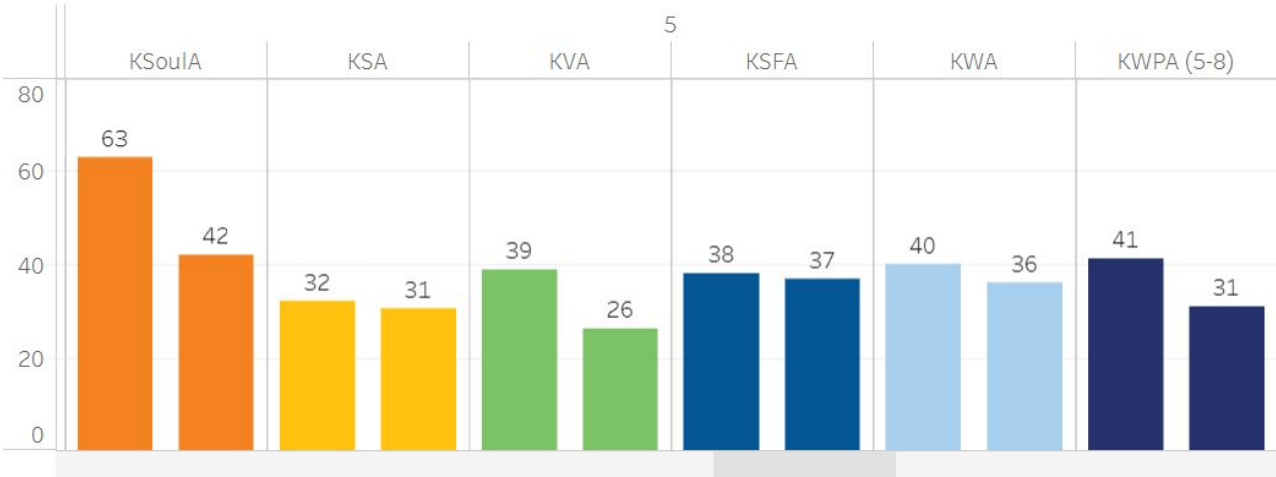


EOY MAP Math Comparative Data: 4 & 5 Growth

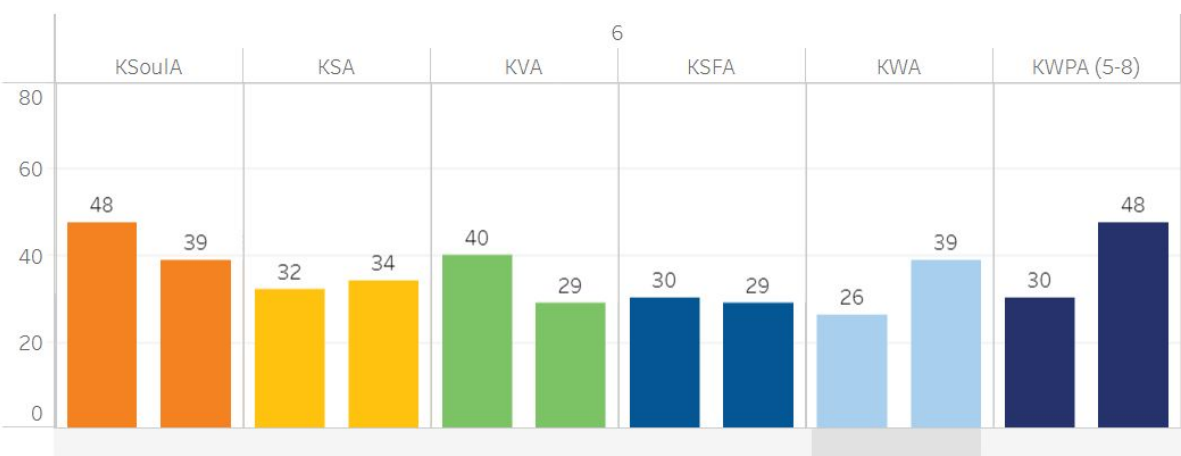

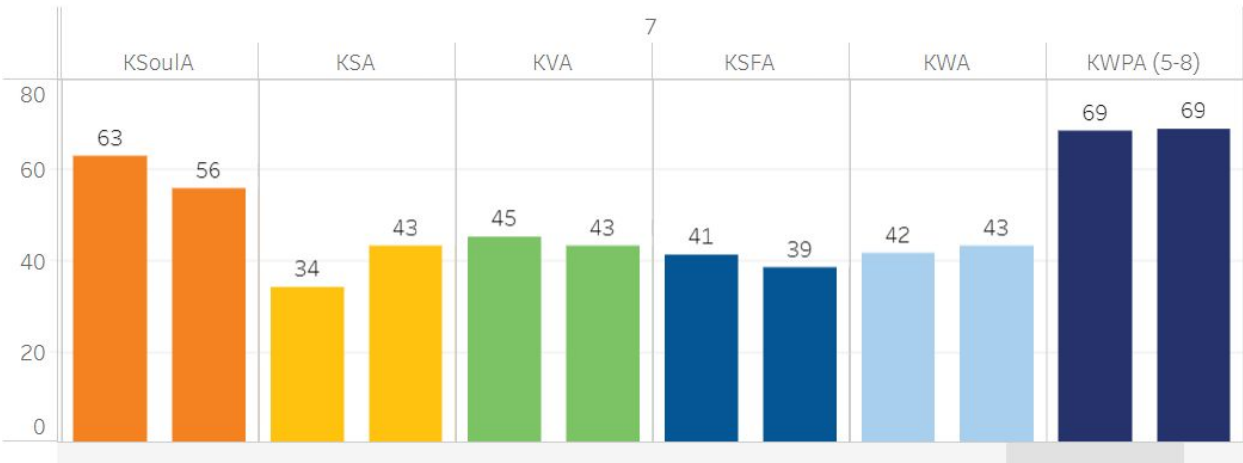


EOY MAP Math Comparative Data: 6 & 7 Growth

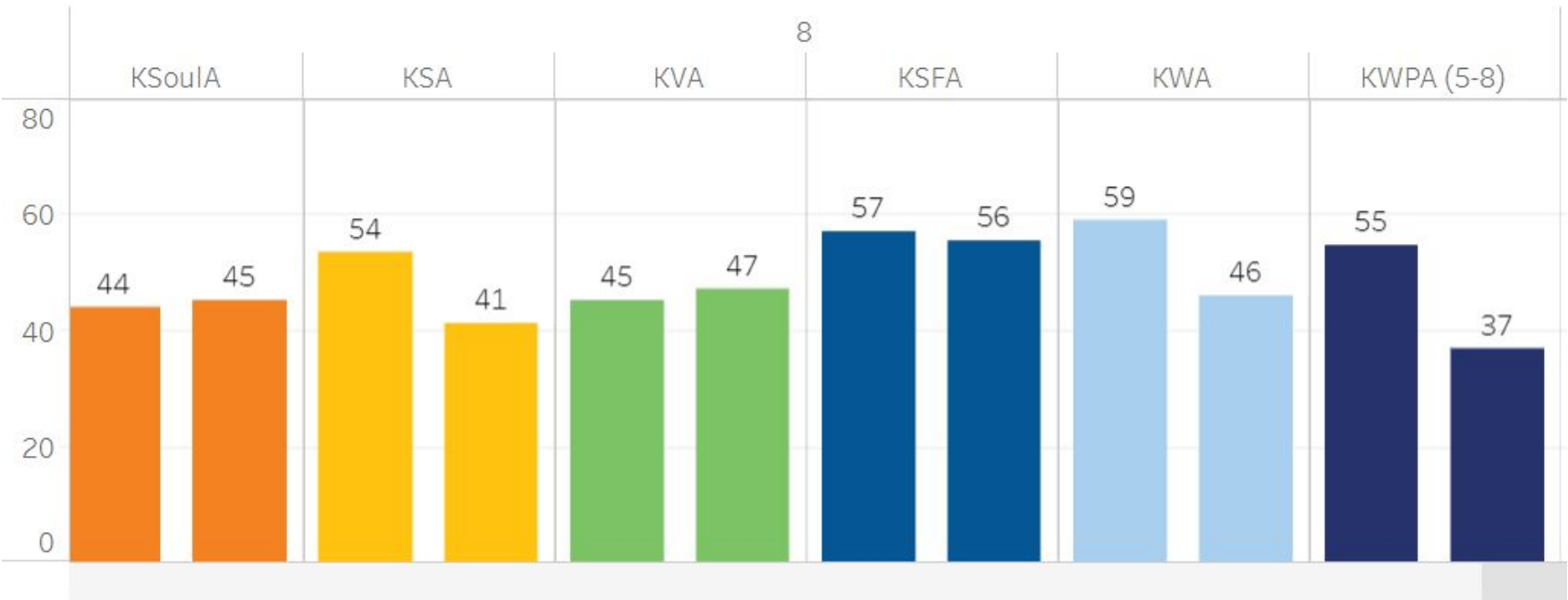

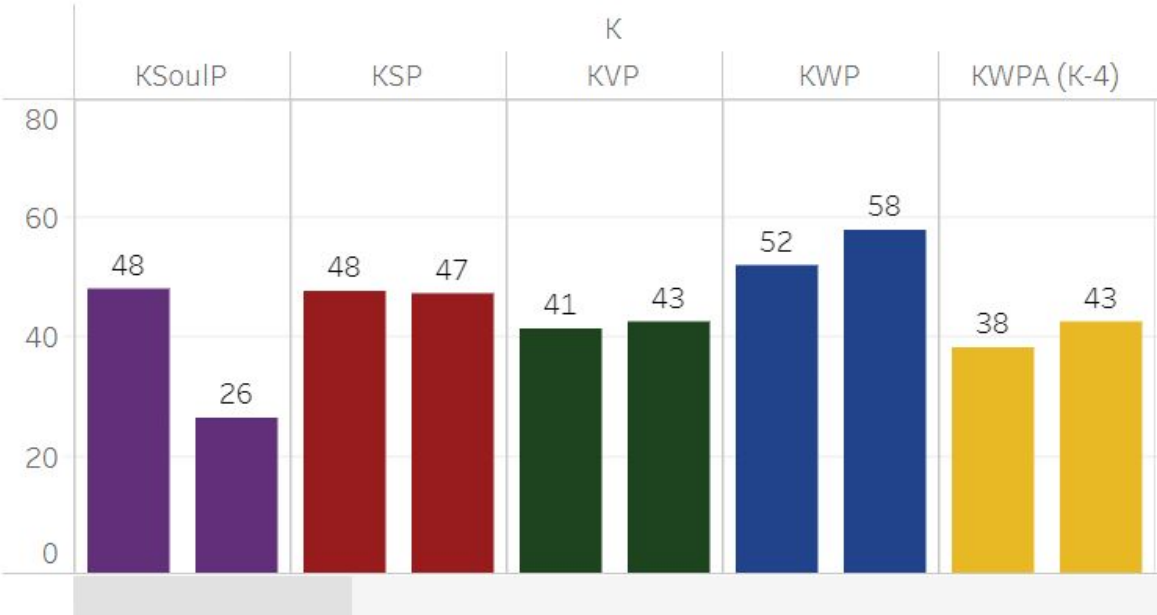
EOY MAP Math Comparative Data: 8 Growth

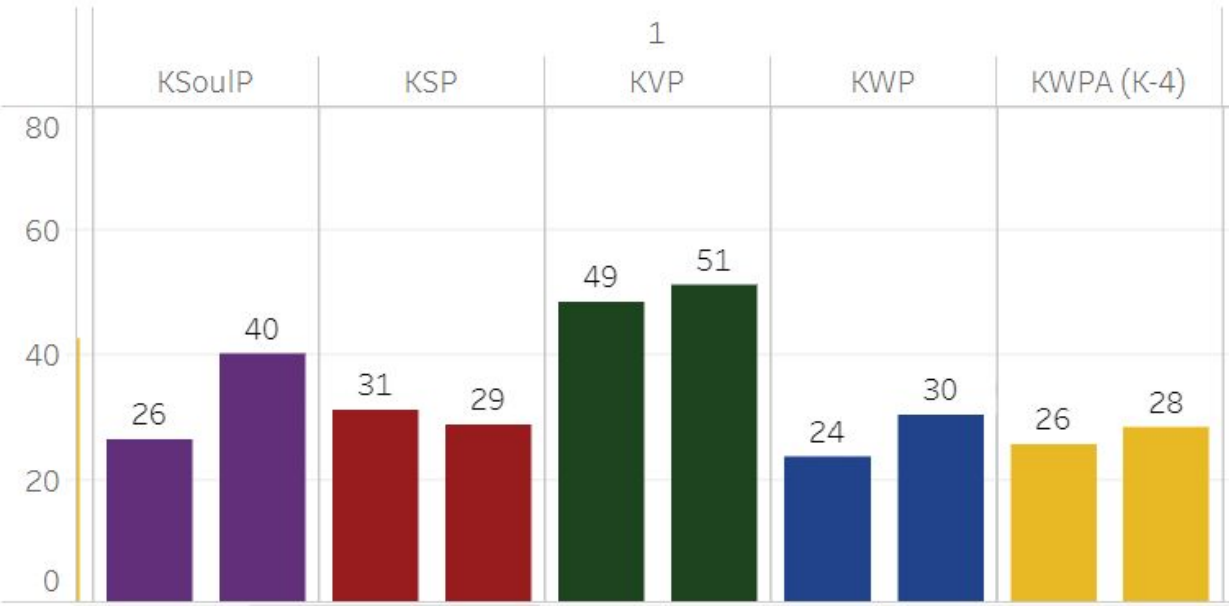


EOY MAP Reading Comparative Data: K & 1 Growth

Median Reading SGP by Grade/School

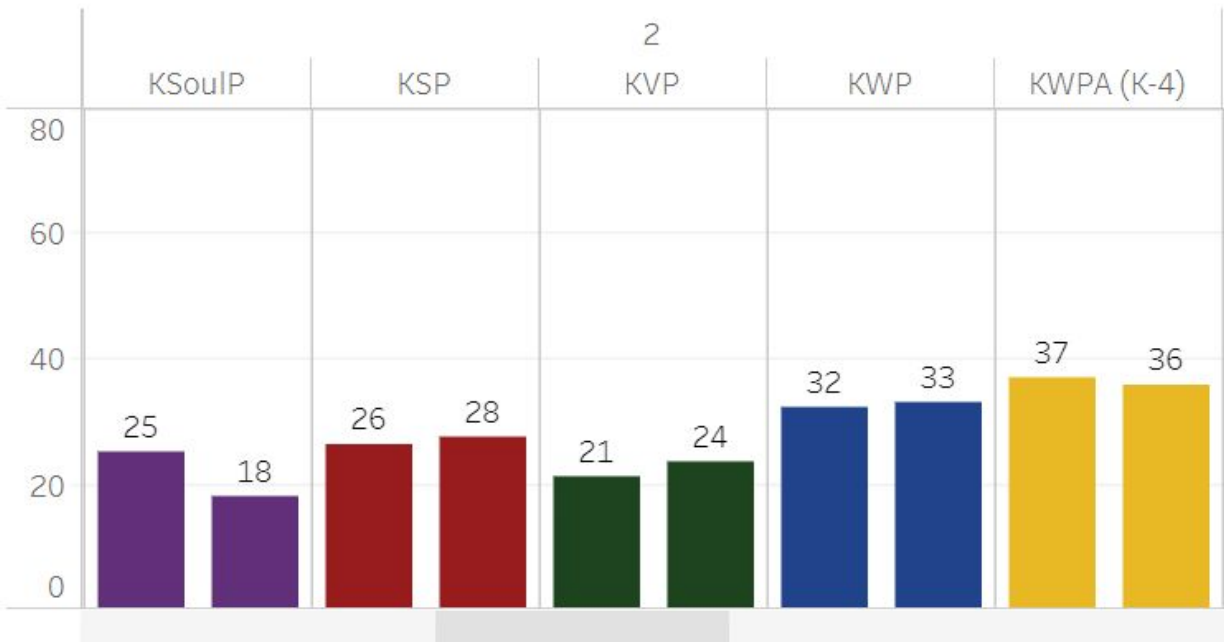

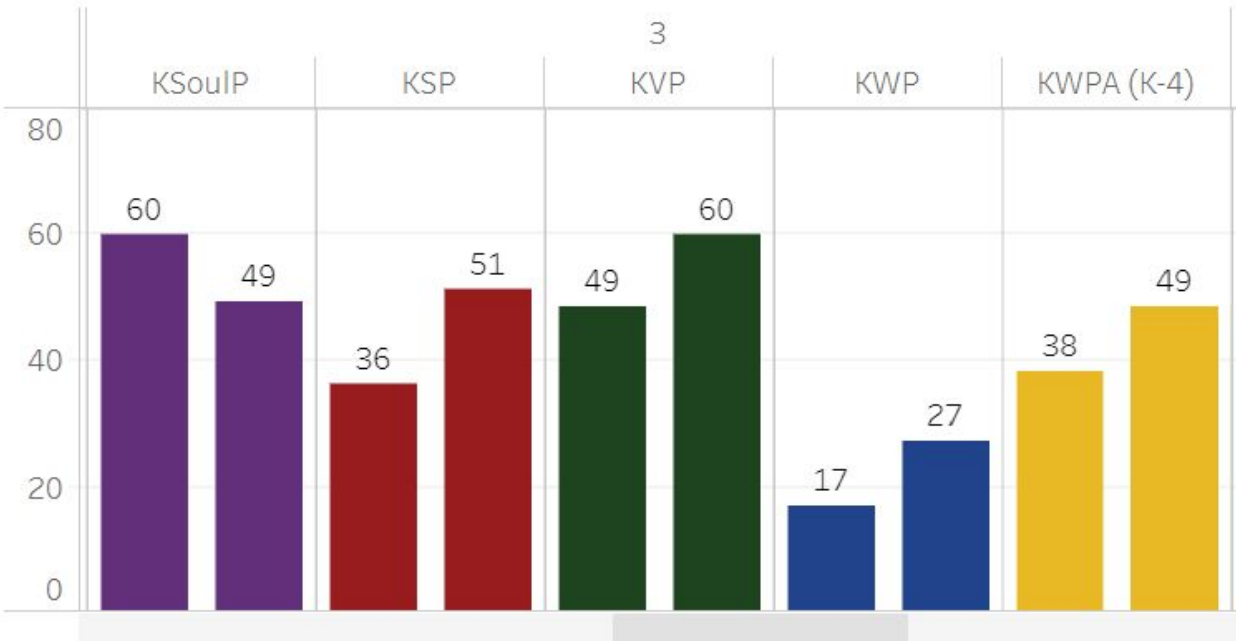


EOY MAP Reading Comparative Data: 2 & 3 Growth

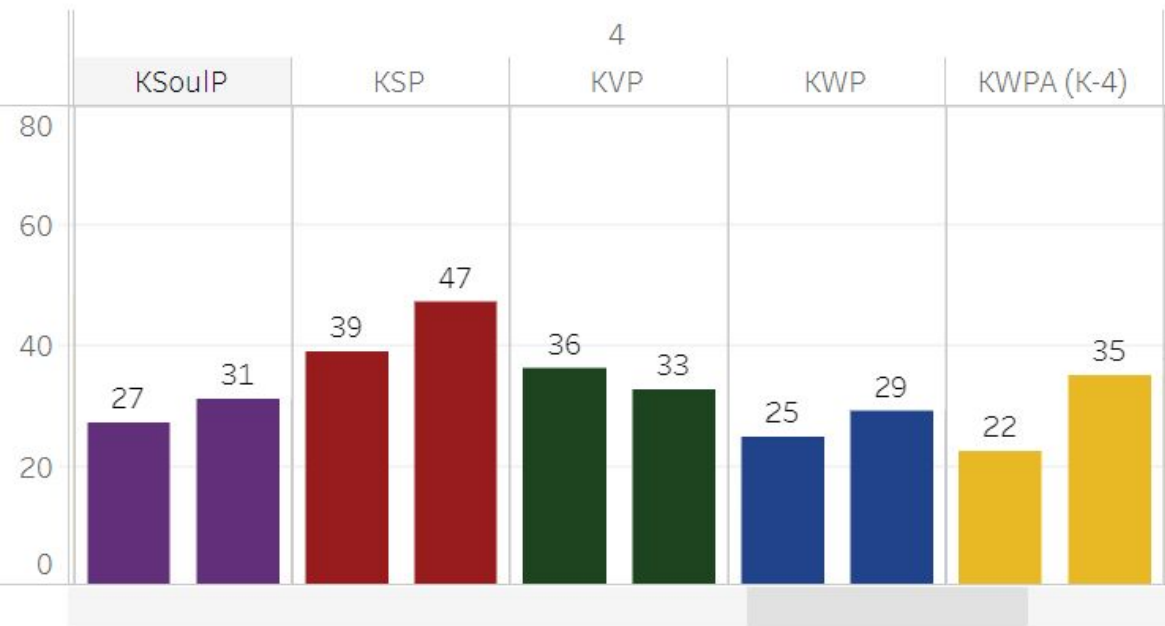

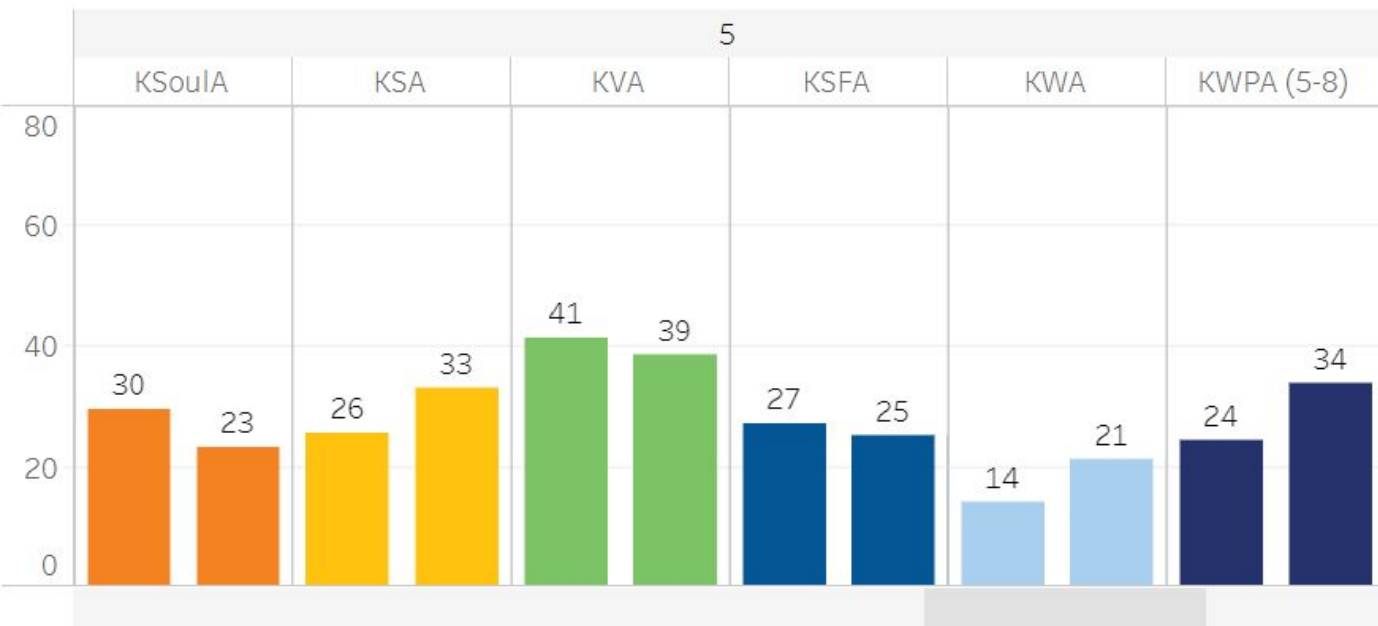


EOY MAP Reading Comparative Data: 4 & 5 Growth

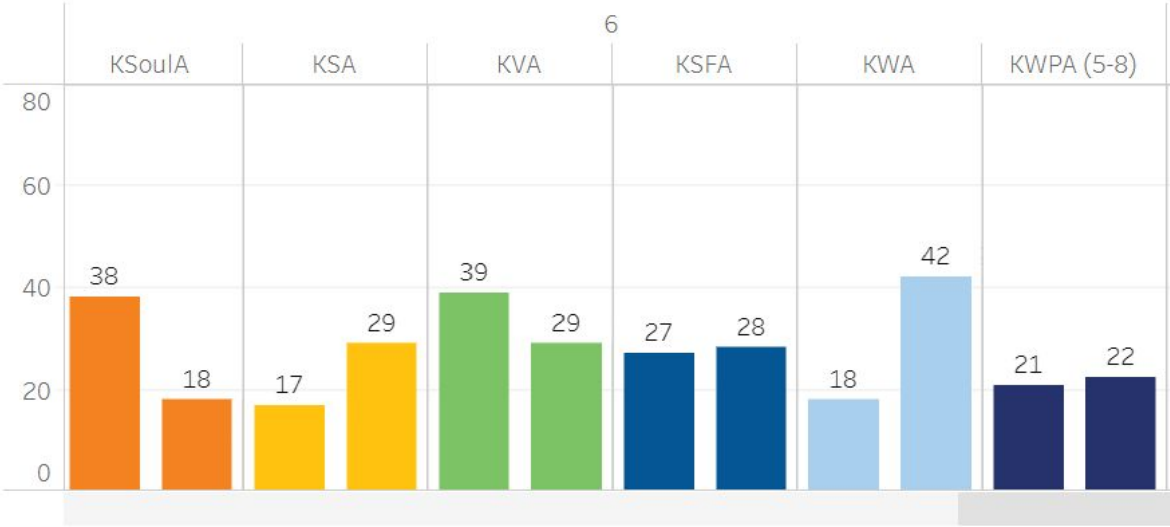

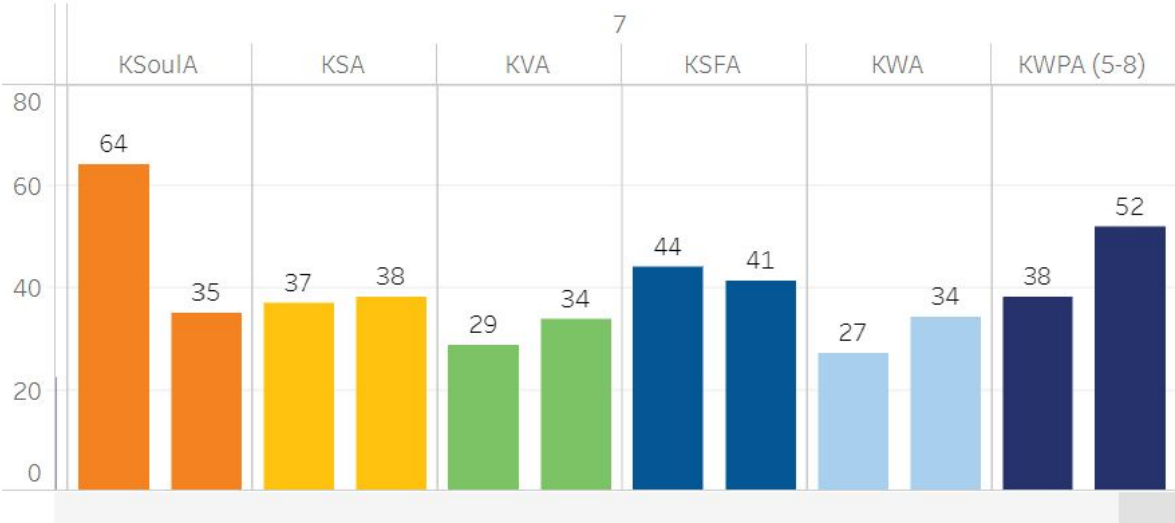


EOY MAP Reading Comparative Data: 6 & 7 Growth

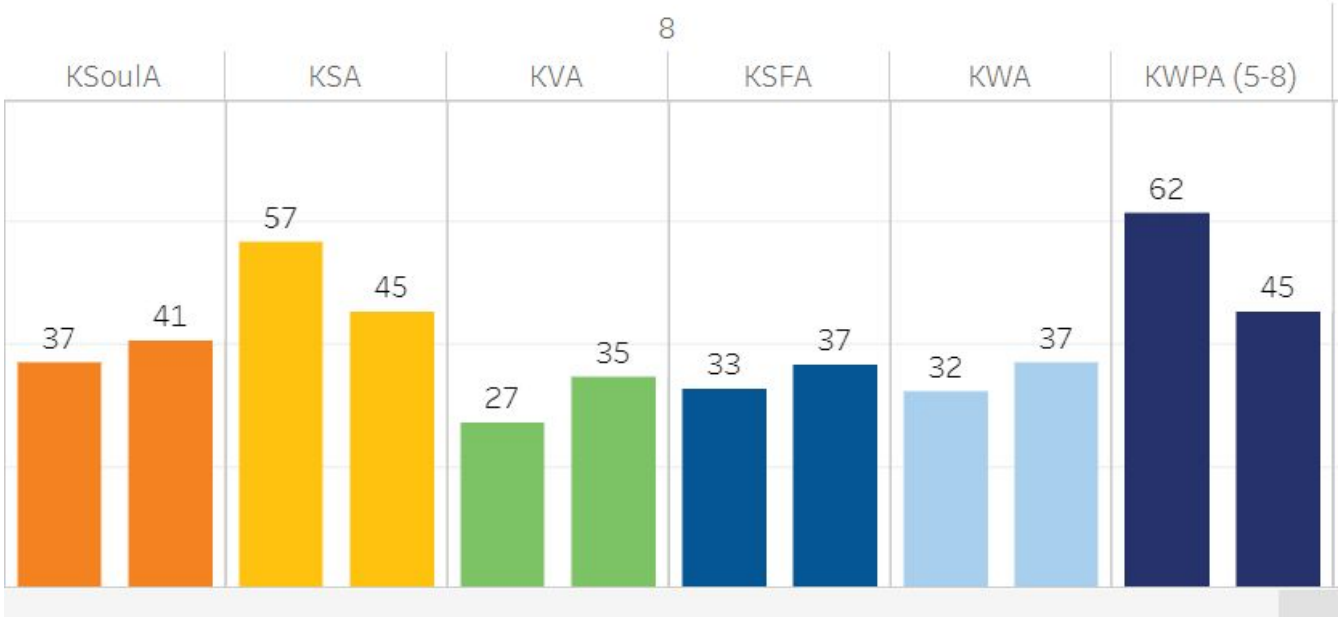
