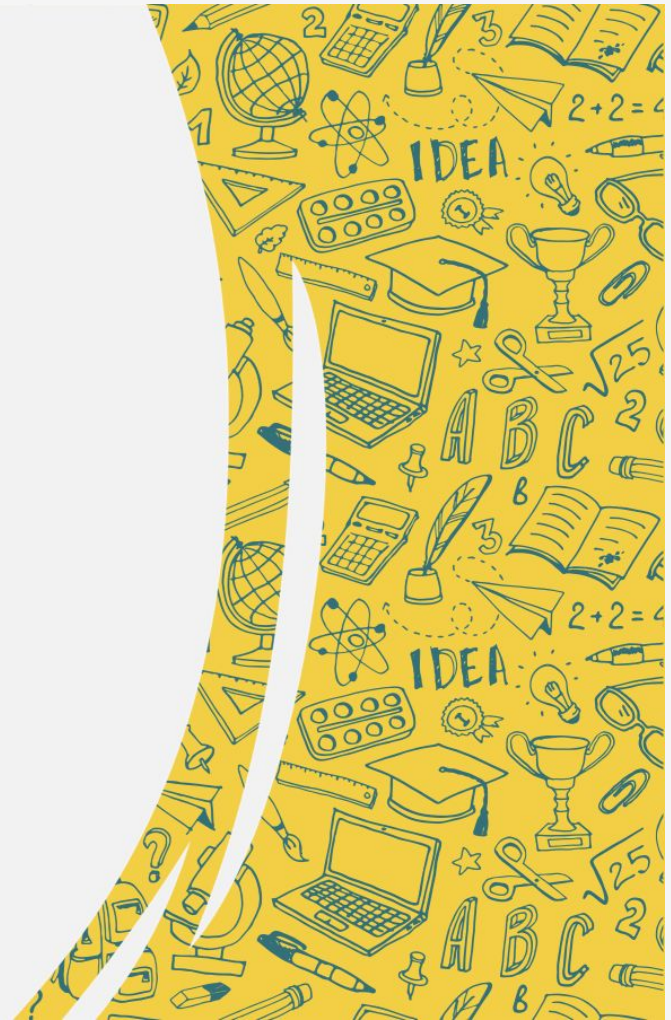

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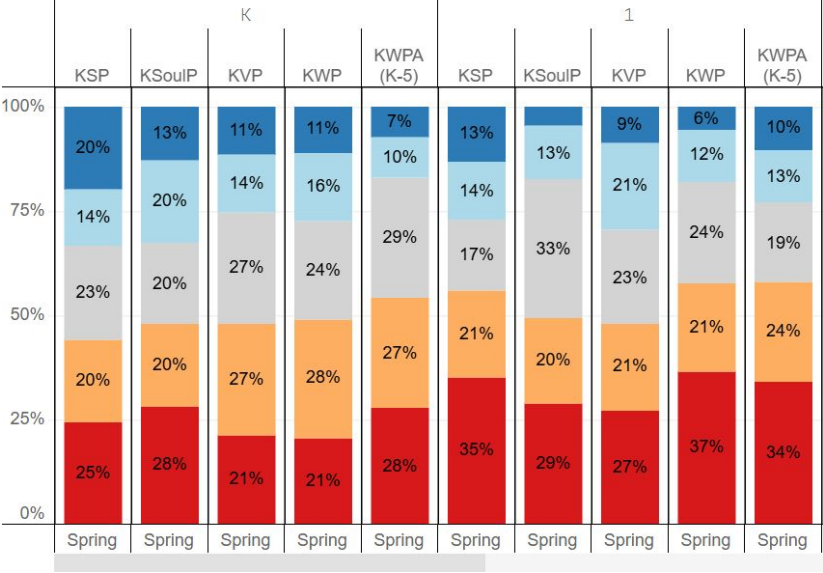

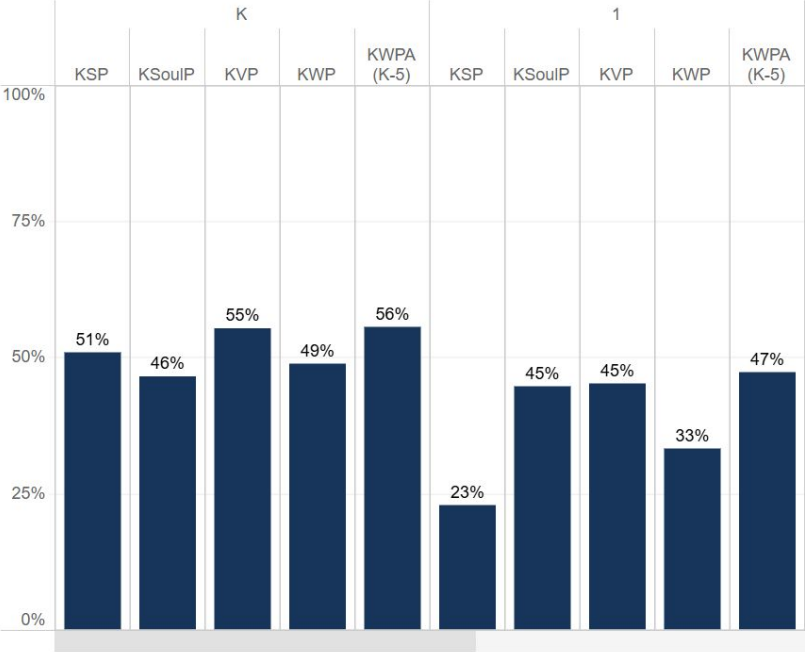


# Spring MAP Data By Grade: Reading

Reading Achievement Quintile - by Grade/School



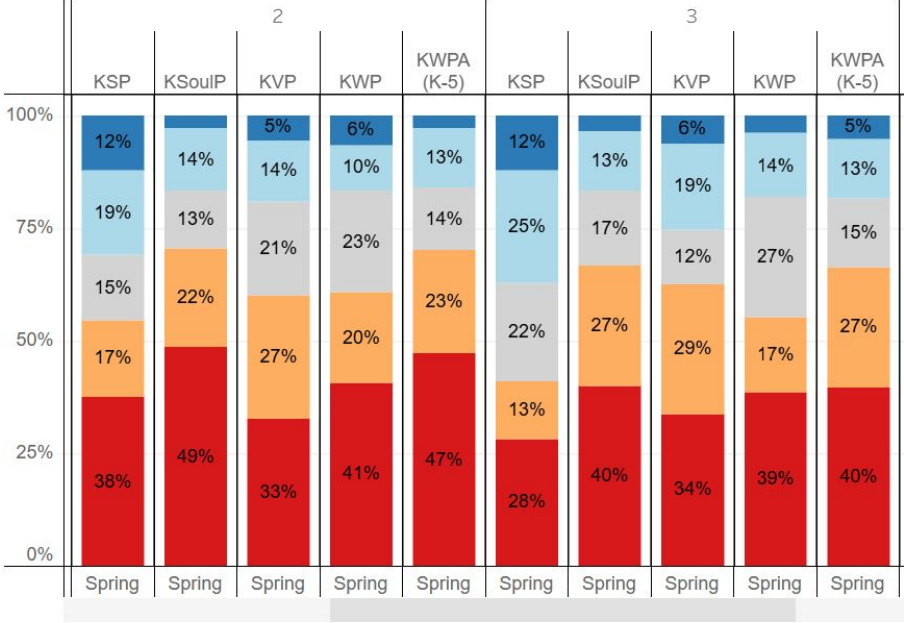
Met Reading Projected RIT Growth - by Grade/School



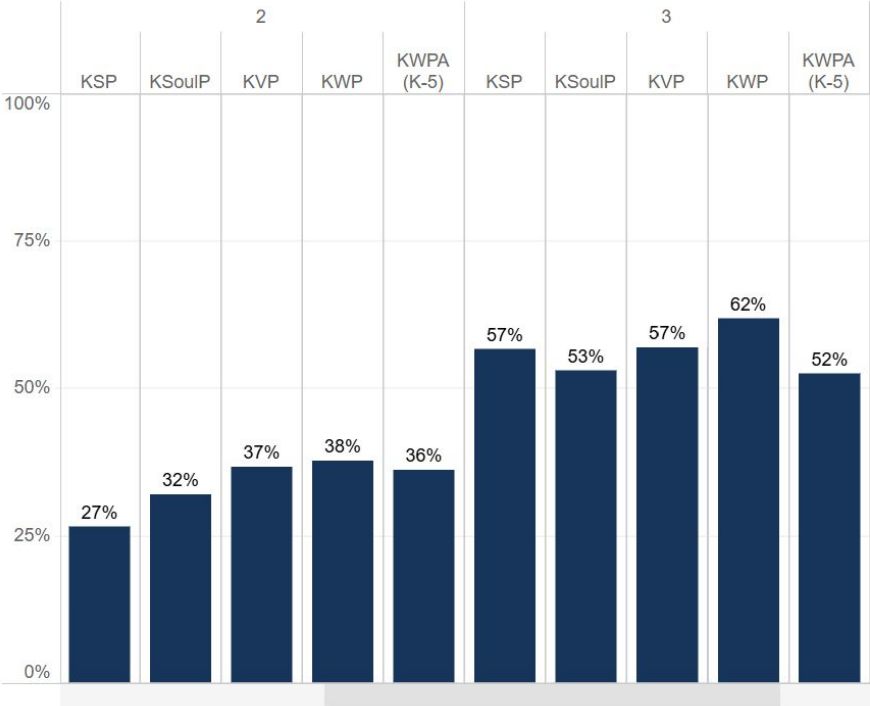

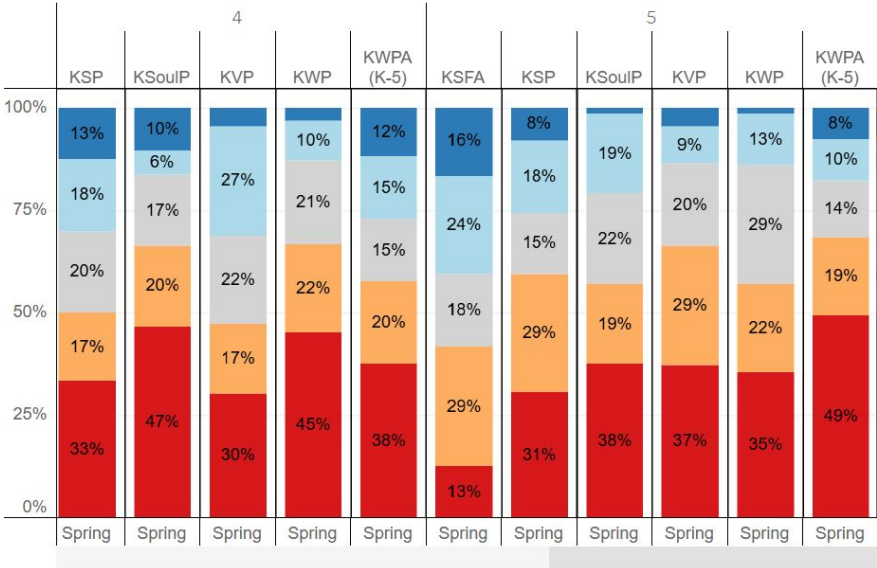


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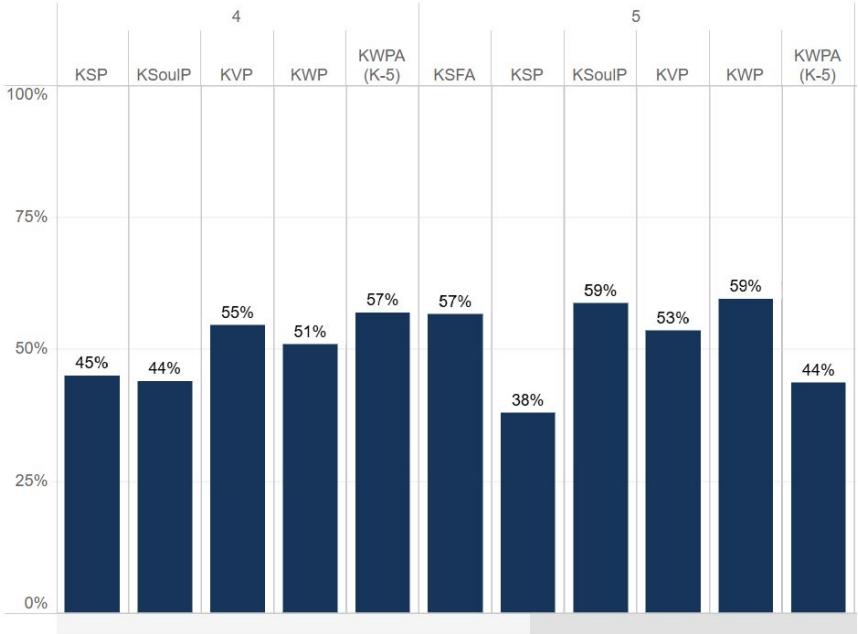


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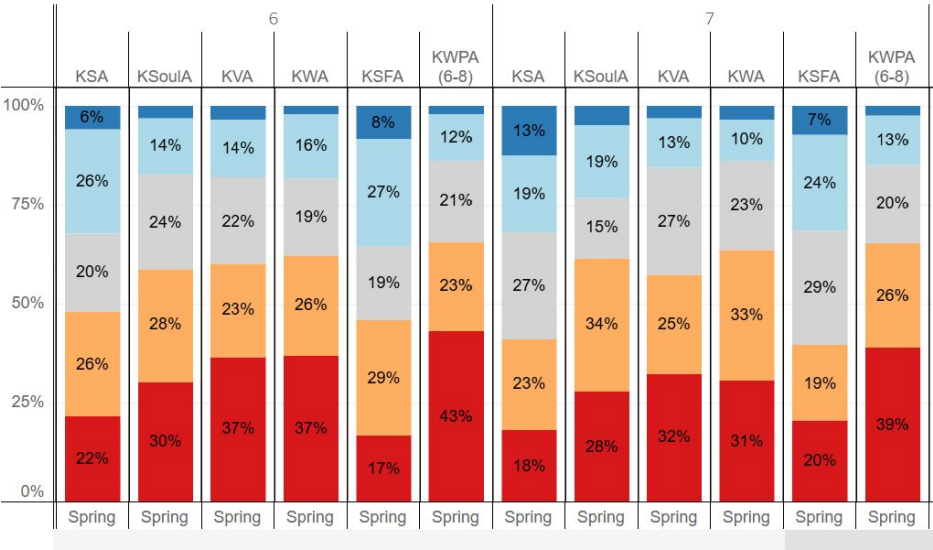


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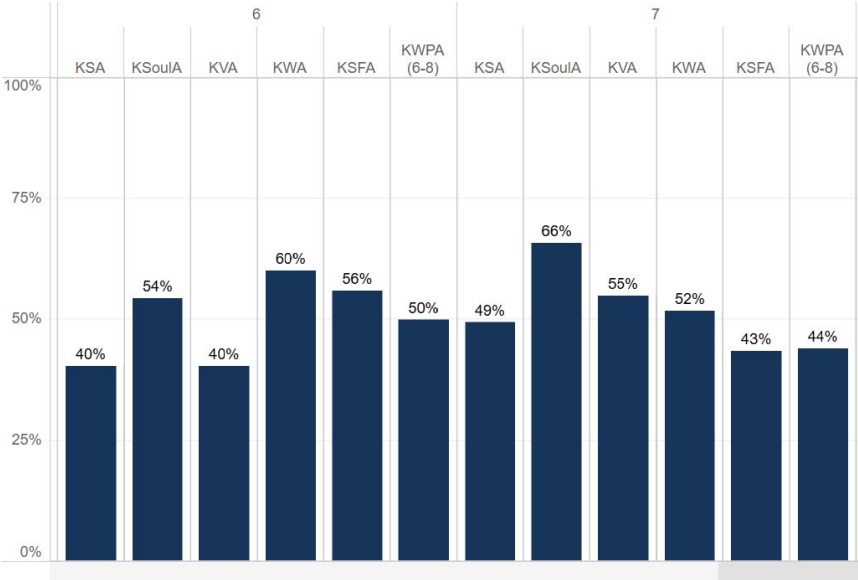


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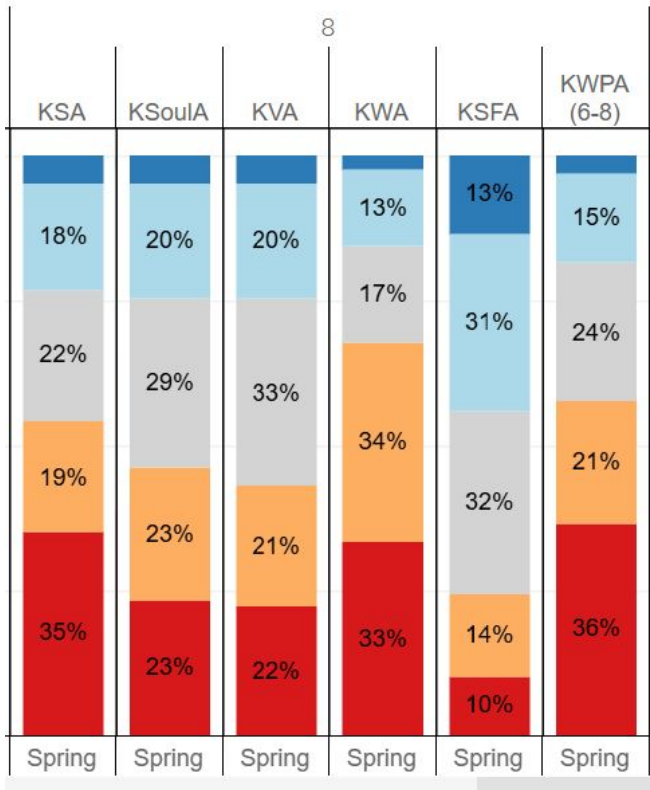


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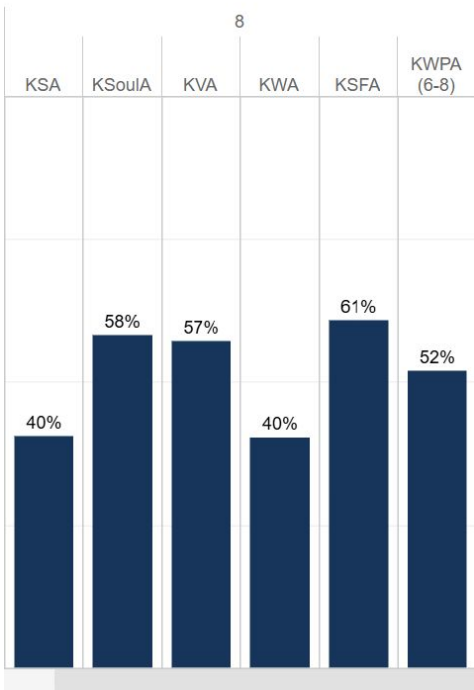


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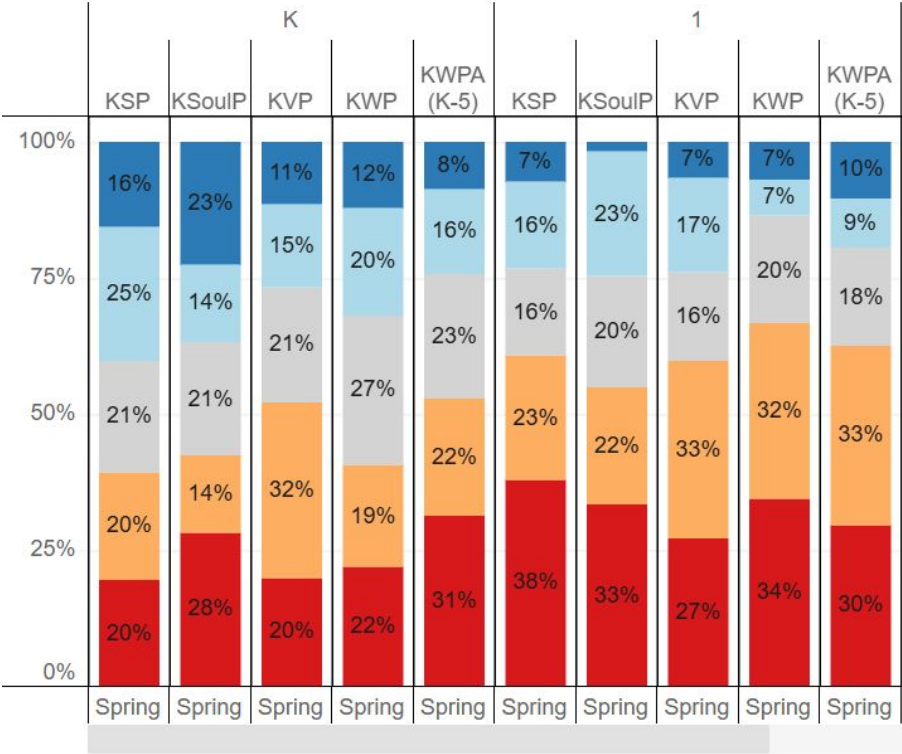


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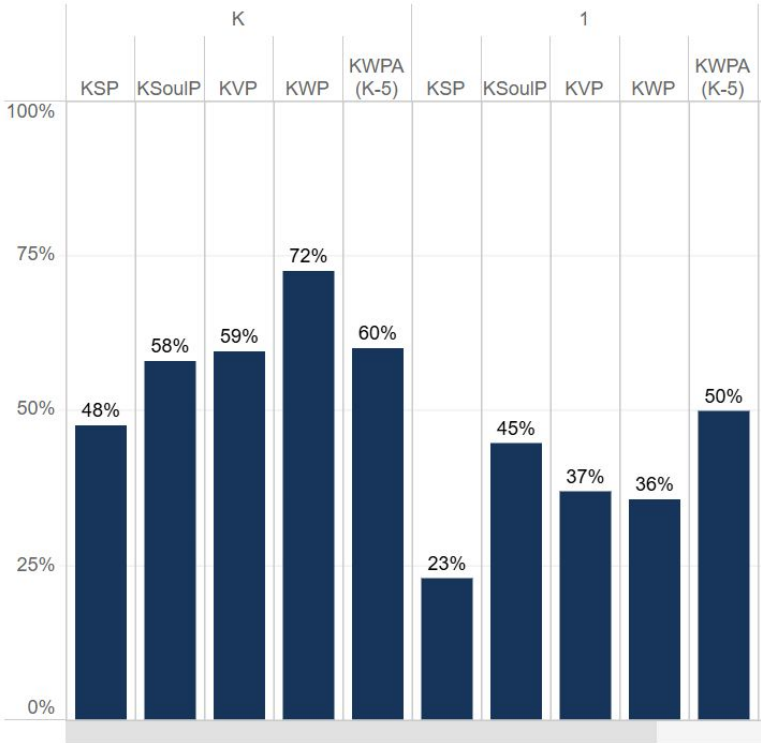


# Spring MAP Data By Grade: Math

Math Achievement Quintile - by Grade/School



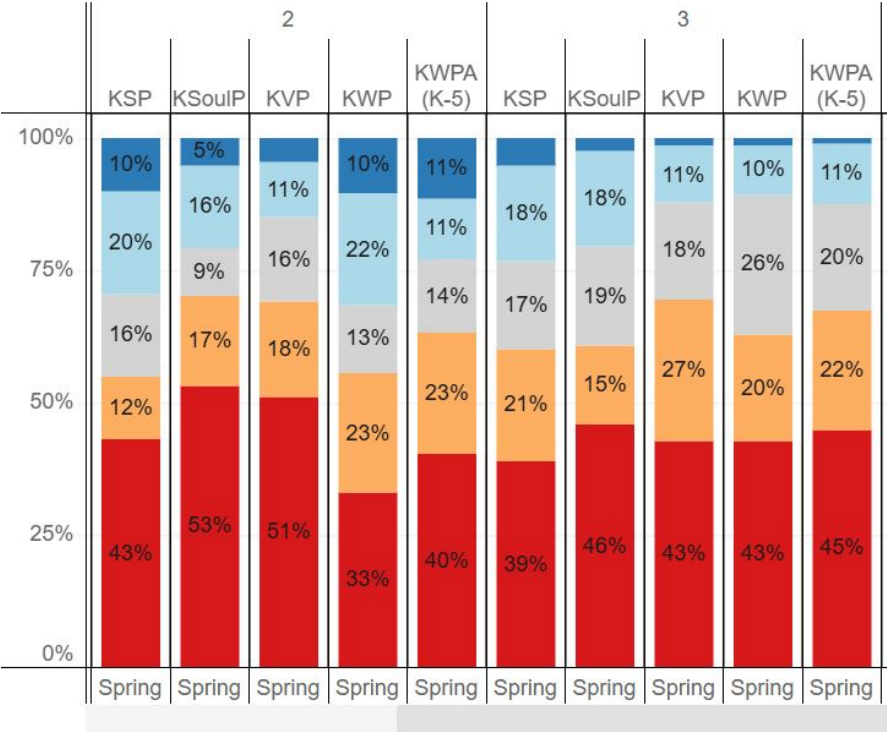
Met Math Projected RIT Growth - by Grade/School



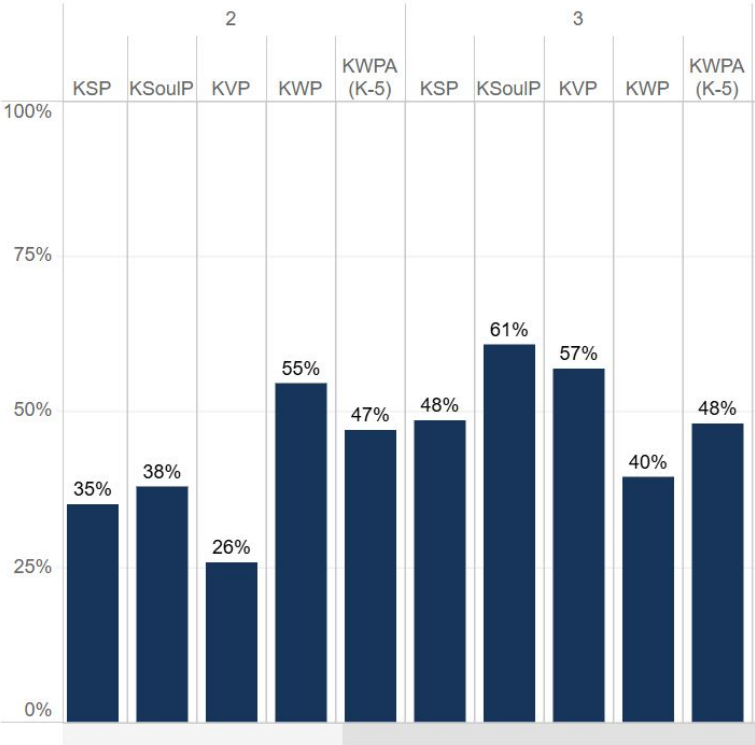

Math Achievement Quintile - by Grade/School

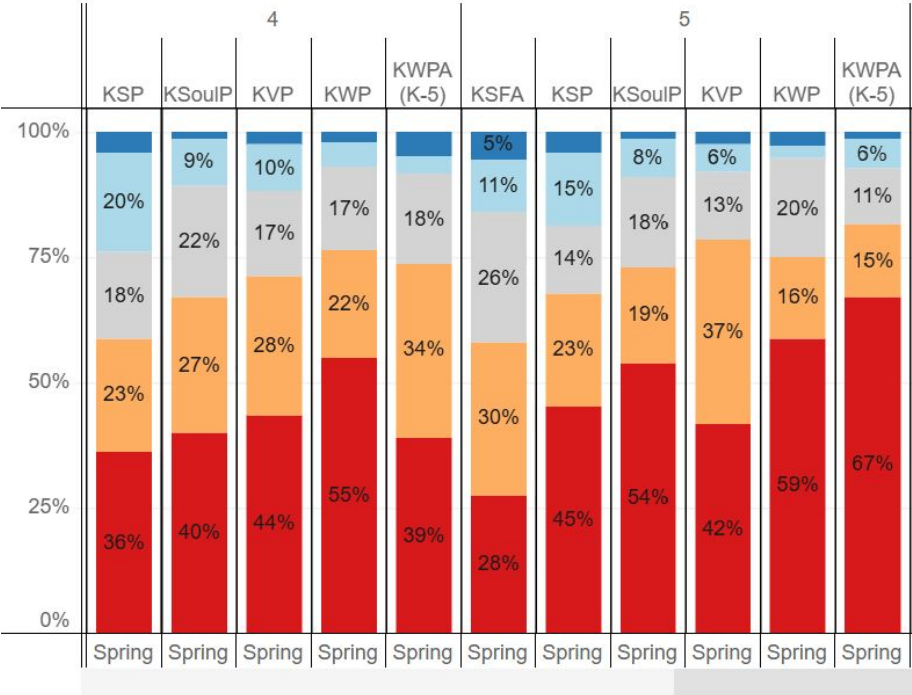
