VI. Discussion Items

- A. School Strategic Plan
 - i. Strategic Plan & Priorities Review
 - 1. Reviewed our 2021-2025 strategic plan with our top five priorities and rationale.
 - a. Hire, retain and develop highly qualified teachers and staff.
 - b. Build teacher capacity in literacy and math.
 - c. Build systems, and resources to support the Cluster Plan and STEM/STEAM implementation.
 - d. Improve student mastery of literacy and math.
 - e. Provide rigor to all students.

ii. SMART Goals

- 1. Reviewed our Continuous Improvement & Strategic Plan
 - a. Increase number of students in the developing or above by 5% for both reading and math for both GMAS and MAP.
 - b. Increase the percentage of CCRPI attendance by 3% from 67% 70%.
- B. Data Discussion
 - i. Spring 2023 MAP Results
 - 1. MAP does not include the writing portion.
 - 2. Overall MAP Data
 - a. More students are in the developing, proficient, and distinguished students as opposed to beginner for ELA and Math combined.
 - b. Reading and Math has seen incremental increases in proficient and distinguished categories.
 - 3. Compared Spring 2022-2023 data to Fall 2023-2024 results.
 - a. Reading 2nd/3rd grade cohort has seen decreases in beginning by 4%; proficient and distinguished has almost doubled.
 - b. Reading 3rd/4th grade cohort has seen increase in beginning; yet, some additional strategies have been issued to remediate this gap from continuing.
 - c. Reading -4th/5th grade cohort has seen significant gains, nearly 11% in reading with a 5% increase in proficient.



- d. Math $-2^{nd}/3^{rd}$ growth already projected.
- e. Math $-3^{rd}/4$ th decreases in beginning with $14^{\%}$ increases in proficiency.
- f. Math 4th/5th trending

 - 1. Reviewed 3rd grade results reading.
 - a. Strive to decrease the beginning level and increase to developing and proficient learner.
 - 2. Reviewed 4th grade results reading.
 - a. Strive to decrease beginning level and increase into developing and proficient learner.
 - b. Increased distinguished learner.
 - 3. Reviewed 5th grade results reading.
 - a. Strive to decrease beginning level and increase into developing and proficient learner.
 - b. Increased distinguished learner.
 - 4. Reviewed 3rd grade results math
 - a. Strive to decrease the beginning level and increase to developing and proficient learner.
 - b. Significant increase in proficient
 - 5. Reviewed 4th grade results math
 - a. Strive to decrease beginning level and increase into developing and proficient learner.
 - b. Increased distinguished learner.
 - 6. Reviewed 5th grade results math
 - Strive to decrease beginning level and increase into developing and proficient learners saw a slight dip but we see gains.
 - b. Increased distinguished learner based.
 - 7. Reviewed: Overall School Performance:
 - a. Significant decrease in beginning learners for ELA.
 - b. More students increased in math proficiency.
 - c. 5th grade science is a huge focus for this year.
 - i. Instructional coach is available to aid the 5th grade teacher with better developing student capacity to past the exam.

- A. Principal's Report
 - i. Enrollment and Leveling Updates
 - 1. Beginning of the year data for actual vs. projected enrollment
 - a. We are under enrollment; influx of students come after the beginning of school within the 14-day evaluation period.
 - b. 474 students enrolled; forecasted to meet 486 students; funded for 455 (pre-K is not included)
 - 2. We experienced a loss of \$223K for the 41 students that disenrolled; equates to two teachers possibly.
 - 3. We had reserves available to help offset the reduction in budget.
 - 4. Community partners can help champion enrollment for the beginning of the year by sharing their experiences.
 - 5. The school is starting earlier with Kindergarten Roundup.
