a. **Discussion Item 1**: 22-23 Budget – School is utilizing a conservative model so we lose any teachers due to leveling.



- i. School is currently placing the 3rd 4th Grade Teacher position on hold (Banking the position) We are currently budgeted for 290 students;
- ii. Switching from Behavior Specialist to Restorative Practices Coach
 - 1. Position implemented 5 yrs ago in APS; has schools look at culture and helps teachers as well as students.
- iii. Addition of Hourly Teacher Tutor (\$18k)
 - 1. Funding was already a allocated for this role
 - 2. Will now have Teacher tutors for K-2 students and 3-5 students
 - This would also decrease the teacher:student ratios in the classroom during tutoring time to allow for more personalized learning

- a. Question Breakdown requested for number of classroom teachers that have resigned – Answer: 9 of 14 Classroom Teachers are not returning. Correlation between higher turnover and staff that have higher student contact.

- ii. IB Candidacy will take 2-3 years to implement and receive consideration. As a result, turnover and retention is even more essential as IIB Training is intensive and costly.
