- b. **Digital Bridge rollout** A lot of questions and talk about the new student laptops is going on in the Sutton class Facebook pages. Katherine has agreed to respond to these posts with the following information.

Signed permission was not required for students to obtain laptops, but parents can read all information pertaining to the digital bridge online on website. Parents could sign to decline. Teachers are not allowed to limit accessibility to computers for homework- a pencil/pen and paper option must be available. Many students with the laptops have to use hotspots to access the internet, and this does not always work. No solution for this problem at this



point, but every classroom as well as the media center have computers for student use. While this doesn't help with homework, all students to have internet access during the school day. Chromebooks were removed from classrooms with the introduction of individual laptops.

Another issue is that students are spending a lot of time playing Minecraft while in class. APS approved Minecraft on the computer because of the educational component, but students are playing it while teachers aren't paying attention. The 7th grade science teachers have embraced Minecraft as a tool in their classrooms. All teachers need to monitor the students and actively supervise the students.

- c. **Meeting dates for 2019-2020 school year:** First Go Team meeting of the 2019-20 school year is scheduled for Monday, September 16, 2019 at 5:30 pm.
