(b) Approve Meeting Agenda

Mr. Blash made a motion to accept the proposed meeting agenda for today's meeting. The motion was seconded by Dr. Ponder. The GO TEAM Members voted unanimously in favor of the meeting agenda and the agenda was approved.

(c) Approve Previous Meeting Minutes

(a) FY2020 Budget Review

He further advised that the majority of the budget is for staffing. Dr. Duncan discussed school allocations and how funding will be allocated for

each budget function. He also discussed turnaround funds and signature program allocations. Dr. Duncan informed GO Team members that the 3rd Floor will be dedicated to our STEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts, Math) initiatives, to include partnerships with Georgia Tech which will continue to support AP Computer Science. Morehouse School of Medicine will oversee Health Certifications for students.

IV. Discussion items

(a) FY' 2020 Budget Feedback

Dr. Neely informed the team that no recommended changes or suggestions to the budget were received via email. Dr. Duncan advised that more funding may be required for transportation due to the rising costs. Ms. Gilyard made a motion to approve the FY' 2020 Budget. The motion was seconded by Dr. Ponder. The GO Team Members voted unanimously in favor of the FY' 2020 Budget and the Budget was approved.
