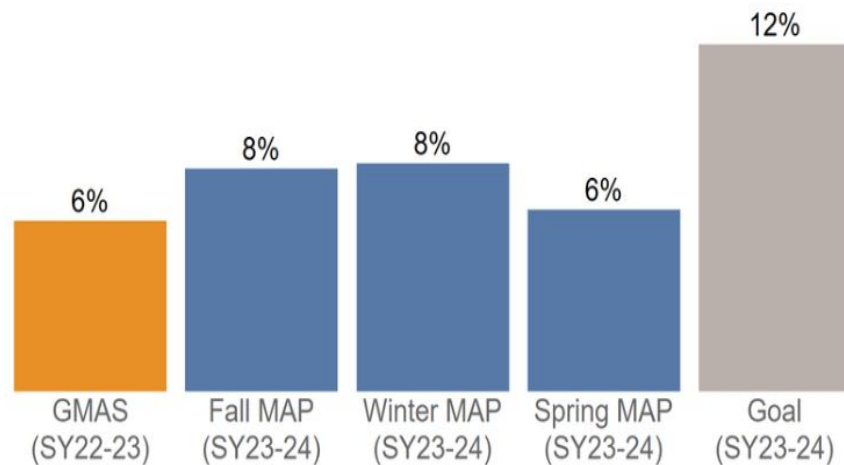

## Proficient & Above (%)





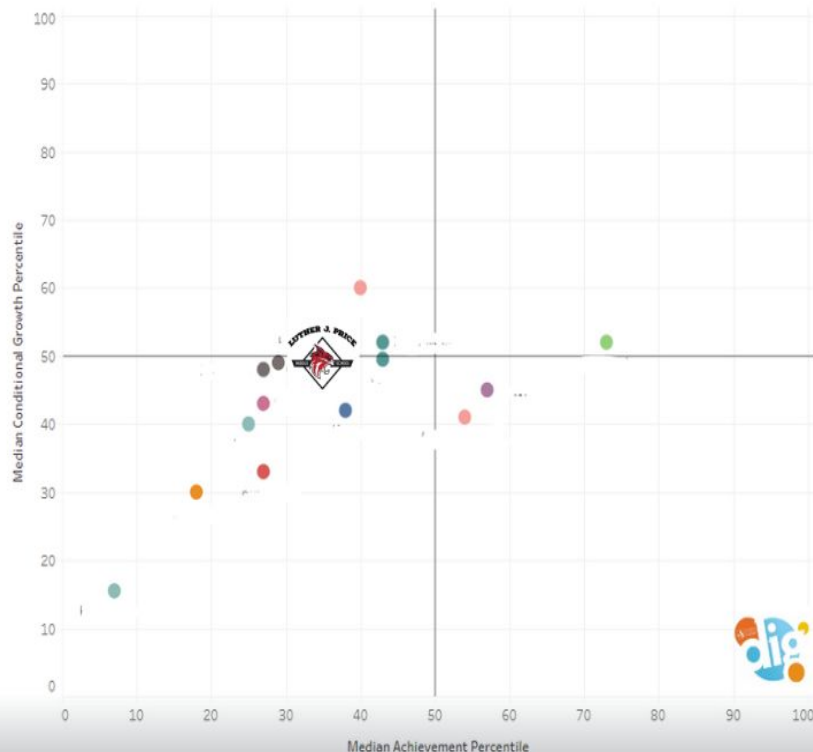
Fall 2023 to Spring 2024 (Across School Year)

Our Fall to Spring growth is **average** compared to the national norm sample.

As Price Wildcats, our students performed in the [33rd Percentile for Achievement](#), and the [49th Percentile for Growth](#) in ELA from the Fall to Spring of this year.

Our Fall to Spring growth is **above average** compared to APS District Schools.

Average district school made **average growth** (45th percentile). Price's rank is **4 out of 15** district schools



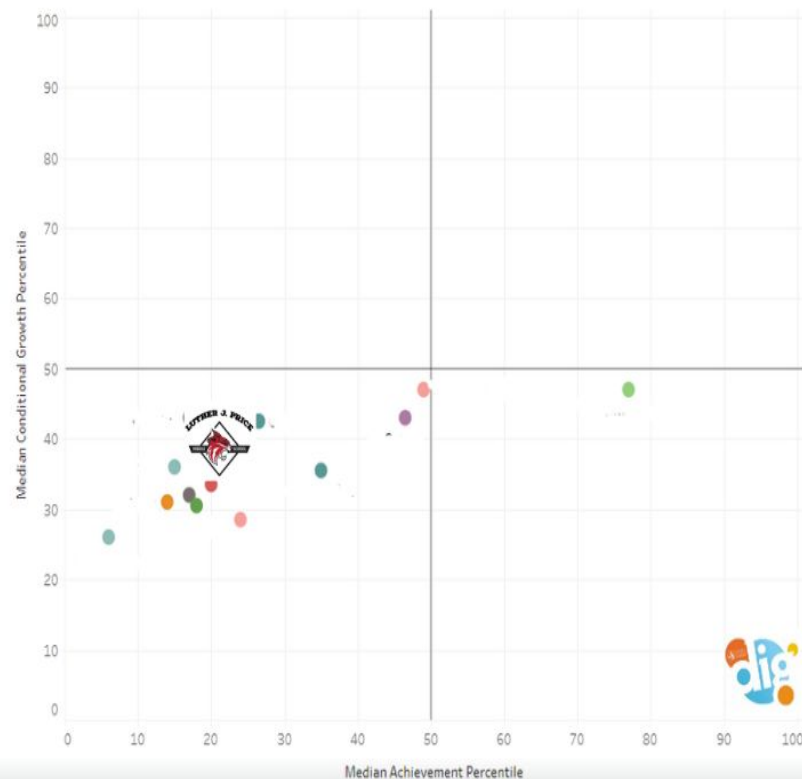
# Fall to Spring Growth and Achievement Data (Price, Fall, Math)
