

Earning Credits is Like Earning Money






Earning HS CREDITS

The credits are used to acquire a HS diploma!








The more education (or specialized training) you have, the higher your earning potential is in the workforce!

CREDITS VS. GRADES



Credits Earned

- Credits are the points you earn for passing classes
- Each class passed = .5 credits
- Passing grade = 70 or above
- If you do not pass a class, you do not earn any credit

There is no GPA requirement to graduate, but you must earn 24 credits (in the right areas) to graduate!

Grade Point Average (GPA)

- GPA is the average of all the grades you earn in your classes
- You earn a grade in every class, whether you pass it or not
- Your GPA impacts what colleges you get in to, the scholarship \$ you earn, etc

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Calculating Your GPA

Grade Point Average is simply the average of all grades earned in HS.



ZEROES: The Wrecking Ball of Grades





A transcript is a complete summary of a student's academic record that includes:

- Every HS course attempted
- When and where each course was taken
- Final grade for each course
- Credits earned (per class, semester and total)
- Overall GPA (average of all final semester grades)
- Class rank
