IV. Discussion Items -video replay at 9:30

a. Current Strategic Plan: video replay at 14:55

Reviewed GO Team timeline, discussed where we are and the systems and processes that are currently in place. Addresses the implementation of best practices by improving student master, closing achievement gaps, implement STEAM; integrate and implement project-based learning. School priority talent management, ensure systems are aligned to school priorities and support STEAM implementation, create a culture of high expectations.



b. Continuous Improvement Plan: video replay at 18:40

Reviewed needs assessment, school-wide SMART Goals and monitoring measures. Strengths are our commitment to continued successes, hire high quality teachers through effective talent recruitment practices and provide our students a fully staffed school. Challenges include CCRPI data which shows 80% of our scholars are reading below grade level; 11% scored proficient on the GA ELA standards (EOG 2019) and 5% proficient on the GA Math standards (EOG 2019). Goals have been set and systems are in place to begin addressing deficiencies. Whole child goal is to decrease the percentage of chronically absent students.

c. MAP Data: video replay at 26:30

Based on EOG EOY we are on the right track with meeting and possibly exceeding our goals of increasing proficiency by lowering the number of developing learners Internal Coherence Survey Data: video replay at 40:10

Survey of 29 questions pertaining to 5 instructional leadership categories. Responses received from a total of 54 teachers. Our scores meet the districts' average on 28 out of 29 questions. Survey data results will be used to address teacher needs.

Amplify Math Data Walkthrough: video replay at 46:55
