IV. Discussion Items (add items as needed)

a. Discussion Item 1:

i. School Strategic Plan & priorities review

Dr. Toney led a discussion about the school's strategic plan, which was created in 2022 and is set to run until 2025. She highlighted the school's mission and vision, as well as their SMART goals, including the ongoing efforts to embed enrichment and intervention blocks into the regular school day. She also discussed the importance of maintaining high attendance rates and the ongoing use of MTSS for interventions.

ii. SMART Goals

The team discussed the school's goals for the upcoming year, focusing on increasing the number of students meeting and exceeding their growth expectations in literacy and numeracy. Dr. Toney emphasized the importance of attendance and the need to identify and support students who missed a significant amount of school

b. Discussion Item 2: Data Discussion

Dr. Toney expressed pride in the school's excellent results, particularly in 5th grade science and the overall school performance. She highlighted the school's focus on daily science education, which contributed to their high science scores in the district. The team discussed the school's growth and potential areas for improvement. She also mentioned the transition from 3rd to 4th and 5th grade, noting that it was the students' first time taking the test. The team ended the conversation with no additional questions.

c. Optional School Uniform The team discussed the possibility of implementing an optional school uniform, with Diane explaining the process outlined in the district dress code policy. The team decided not to explore the idea of an optional school uniform
