The team discussed various strategies to address performance challenges among economically disadvantaged students and reviewed the school's mission, vision, and purpose while considering the addition of STEAM to their educational approach. The meeting also focused on reviewing and aligning the school's mission, vision, and purpose with the district's goals. Go Team members discussed the



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importance of reading skills and student-staff relations, as well as community engagement initiatives. They also evaluated the effectiveness of parent portal usage and considered ways to improve teacher compensation. The group decided to maintain their current mission statement while adding "STEAM" to their vision statement to reflect their focus on interdisciplinary teaching and global perspectives.
