 goals for achieving goals (ie. including more Science within
 Literacy, making time for remediation with the end of WIN blocks,
 Math standards and requirements), Whole Child & Intervention
 CIP Goal (recognition, etc)
 - ii. SMART Goals
- b. Data Discussion (link to data)
 - MAP Scores Math Achievement levels, relatively flat Fall to Spring;
 Reading Achievement levels, also relatively flat Fall to Spring
 *Achievement level = "how much they know"
 *Growth score = Fall RIT Score avg. applied to expectation for growth to Spring, green meets expectation, while red falls below
 - Milestone Scores

Note: Math scores not yet available publicly this is a criterion referenced test - 9th in district in overall achievement (Proficient & Distinguished + Gains), +5.5% growth in Reading

Notably, 2022-2024 Y/Y **Reading** growth is greatest from yellow to green while red remains relatively equal Only 5th grade takes **Science**, 3 year scores are flat to down further emphasizing the importance of integrating science into other subjects while giving space to teachers to focus on Science; another opportunity is within the DLI program in which Science is taught in Spanish and tested in English

- GLOWS & GROWS
 - Glows Reading growth in subgroups, +5.5%; SWD, ELL & Black groups growth
 - Grows science instruction time; science bridge into small groups for DLI
