#### IV. Discussion Items

- a. **Discussion Item 1**: Facilities Master Plan
  - i. APS to determine which buildings are under or over capacity. Started before the pandemic.
  - ii. Enrollment has fallen by 2k students during the pandemic with elementary affected most notably and kindergarten specifically. S Atl and Carver has most significant decrease at -10%. Our cluster had an -8% change. Kids leaving have gone to charter schools and private schools. Jackson -31% and Hutchinson -31% change in last 2 years.
  - iii. Population and housing trends/forecasting included
    - 1. 50% live in single family home, 31% live in rental home in APS
  - iv. School capacity North Atl Cluster
    - 1. Grady has most growth along with Jackson cluster
    - 2. E Rivers school capacity is 1,105. Our utilization rate is 59%. We are projected to grow over 100 students (total 795 students) over the next 5 years due to Huff Road, Chattahooche, Marietta Blvd corridor. We are projected to grow another 50 students in 10 years (847 students) for a capacity rate of 77% by 2031-2032.
    - 3. Rezoning for E Rivers is not on the table (but is for other schools in our cluster)
