Active Sports

Outdoor Explorers - An expert Blue Heron Naturalist will help students make exciting finds in nature and learn how to explore safely as they search for insects, rocks, birds, and more in the schoolyard habitat. By spending hands-on time in nature, students will learn to care for living things and build their own scientific understanding of the natural world through discovery, observation, and experimentation.

Spring 2025 Price: \$210 10 sessions/once a week

WePickle - This activity is an excellent way to keep kids physically active. It provides a full-body workout, engaging muscles, improving cardiovascular health, and promoting endurance. The fast-paced nature of the game keeps children constantly on the move, burning calories, and building strength. Regular participation in pickleball can contribute to mental engagement, which enhances cognitive skills, such as concentration, problem-solving, and decision-making abilities.

Spring 2025 Price: \$235 10 sessions/once a week

Soccer Shoots - The program is devised to help young players learn the basics of soccer while enjoying interactive games in a fun, learning environment. Students will have the opportunity to meet college players and attend local games. Additionally, they can become part of the team by walking players out onto the field; participating as ball boys/girls; or, sitting amongst the fans, soaking up the atmosphere.

Fine Arts

Brilliant Bilingual - Students of all proficiency levels, will participate in a Spanish Club that uses fun games, projects and speaking activities to help students express information about themselves and about the world around them in Spanish. Students will build a family tree and describe members; learn vocabulary and phrases to introduce and describe



family members and create a model of their home or residence while practicing home-related vocabulary.

Spring 2025 Price: \$275 10 sessions/once a week

Brush & Needle – The goal is to develop creativity in students. We believe the ability to think artistically has a positive effect on a child’s self-confidence and freedom in their thoughts. During the sessions, students draw, paint, glue, work with scissors, as well as use many other tools, while exploring different mixed techniques and all sorts of art materials.

Spring 2025 Price: \$285 10 sessions/once a week

KidsTV Film - During this film-making class, students work with professional filmmakers to learn the basics of filmmaking. The class works as a team to produce an original short film, TV show, or music video. The class will create a script; learn camera operations, lighting, and producing. Then, the class will work as a production crew to shoot their films, show, or music video.

STEAM Courses

Code Ninja - This curriculum will guide students through the entire process of developing their own app. Students will progress through brainstorming, planning, building, and testing phases of app building. By the end of the class, students will have a complete (but unpublished) app of their very own.

Epic Engineers -Using the Engineering Design Process, students will explore different types of engineering such as aerospace, chemical, civil, electrical, marine, and mechanical. Engineering For Kids’ programs are Cognia STEM Certified, STEM.org. Accredited, and aligned with National Teaching Standards. With basic household and specialty supplies, the students will build individual and group projects that stay afloat, defy gravity, whoosh, and hopefully stand firm.
