How do we calculate Isolation/Quarantine dates:

Quaranteaching participation:

Your student's teacher will be in contact regarding the process for quaranteaching participation!

Chromebooks and Hotspots:

<u>Chromebooks:</u> If you are in need of a Chromebook for your student during quaranteaching time, you may check one out from the MES front office.

<u>Hotspots</u>: If you are in need of a hotspot for internet connectivity, please visit the MES Website under Teaching and Learning → Quaranteaching to request one. The hotspots come from the warehouse at the district and are delivered to the school. There is a several day lead time to receive a hotspot.

Attendance:

If students are not present in class, students will be marked by teachers as Unexcused Absence (UNA) for attendance. Following the student's quarantine or isolation period, the core subject teacher(s) will provide the MES attendance team with a report of participation in quaranteaching. If a teacher reports that a student has participated in quaranteaching, the student's attendance code will be changed to QRT (indicating quarantined and present for quaranteaching). This code is not considered an absence, but rather indicates that the student was not physically present in the building, but has participated in instruction. Quarantine teaching does not include specials and this will not count against a student's grade.

<u>NOTE</u>: The Attendance Committee meets on Thursdays. If your student ends quarantine/isolation on a Friday, the attendance codes will not be adjusted until after the Attendance Committee meets on the following Thursday.
