E. Rivers students again have the opportunity to participate and win rewards as part of the exciting Accelerated Reading (AR) Program - ROARING RIVERS READERS! This year our reading theme is Books: Your Passport to Adventure! As part of our Kickoff, we want everyone to dress in their favorite International Attire on August 25th!

This year students meeting their grade level goal will be acknowledged at the end of each 9 weeks with a certificate and donuts or ice cream (grade level goals are listed below). We will not have double or triple point awards this year. We want to encourage more readers to meet their grade level goals!

Accelerated Reader is a computer-based program that is used to monitor reading practice and progress. It helps teachers guide students to books that are on their reading level and build confidence in their reading. Students take short quizzes after reading a book to check for comprehension. To take the AR quizzes log into MyBackpack with your child's username and password. Quizzes can be taken at home or at school.

Many books are part of the AR Program – these books can be found in the classrooms, in the library, in your home, or as ebooks on MyOn in MyBackpack. To check to see if a book you own is an AR book, you can log into Accelerated Book Finder at www.arbookfind.com and type the title of your book.
