a. Discussion Item 1: School Strategic Plan

A strategic planning session was held to re-ground the team in the mission and vision of HAES and to broaden our strategic priority. The smart goals were revisited as well during this planning session.

b. Discussion Item 2: Universal Screener Data-School and/or Grade level reports MAP and BASC-3

The BASC-3 universal screener is a new initiative for Atlanta Public Schools. It used to assess the wellness of the scholars we are serving. The screener was completed by teachers, parents and students in grades 3rd-5th to collect a wide variety of behavior and social and emotional data. This platforms gives us tiered level evidence based interventions.

APS is no longer using the STAR assessment as the universal screener.

MAP Assessments: Oral Reading Fluency for scholars in grades Prek-3rd, Map
Growth Reading and Map Math administered to scholars in K-5th grade 3 times per year.

- c. Discussion Item 3: A.C.E.S Review
 - A.C.E.S Process—Accountability, Continuous Improvement, Equity and Support Every principal in the district had to present to the superintendent and her cabinet specific points on what's happening at their schools and what they are focusing on for the next few months.
