Staff is very appreciative of all the nice things they are getting during teacher appreciation week.

All teachers have done an incredible job this year.

Go Team voting coming up very soon – look for updates

Last Foundation meeting was last night so a new board is being voted in.

District did decide that last day of school is going to be an in person day – Wednesday.

Conversation about adding an additional 30 minutes at the end of the day next year – to 3pm. As an option to help recoop academic time from pandemic/virtual year.

Katie and Denise came on tonight because there will be summer school in the building this year. Currently open to all of the students and all of the schools in the grady cluster, it is free but enrollment is not off the charts so some may be merged.

# **Summer School Questions:**

3hrs of academic instruction – split into two sessions, 30 minutes of recess, 90 minutes of team activities by a third party vendor. June 2 – June 30.

Official APS on summer school is to attend all four weeks, but Mary Lin is open and flexible. If you can be there more than half the time, they think you should sign up.

Questions on ELA/Math and if there can be a focus on certain things so the kids can focus on areas that they need enrichment on vs. something they don't need that assistance. Everyone is invited – remediation and acceleration.

Trying to keep classes at max 15:1 with paraprofessionals in Kindergarten and  $1^{st}$  grade – there is a grant that is helping fund and it emphasizes a smaller student / teacher ratio.

There is a difference between summer school and extended school year (ESY). ESY is focused on special education.

As of now, depending on enrollment, Mary Lin kids will be at Mary Lin, and other kids will most likely stay at their schools. Enrollment seems to be similar – 50-60 at Spark, 60-80 at Morningside, 50ish now at Mary Lin, smaller number at Hope Hill currently.

Breakfast and lunch are free at summer school too!
