Treasurer's Report - Janet Patton

- Fiscal year is July to June
- Last year's gross profit was \$69,323.02, expenses were \$63,329.16, and PTA carried over \$5,534.53
- Income comes from school events, fundraisers, and dues
- Money goes to beautification, teacher allotments, expenses for running activities and events
- PTA has rolled over \$5-6k each year
