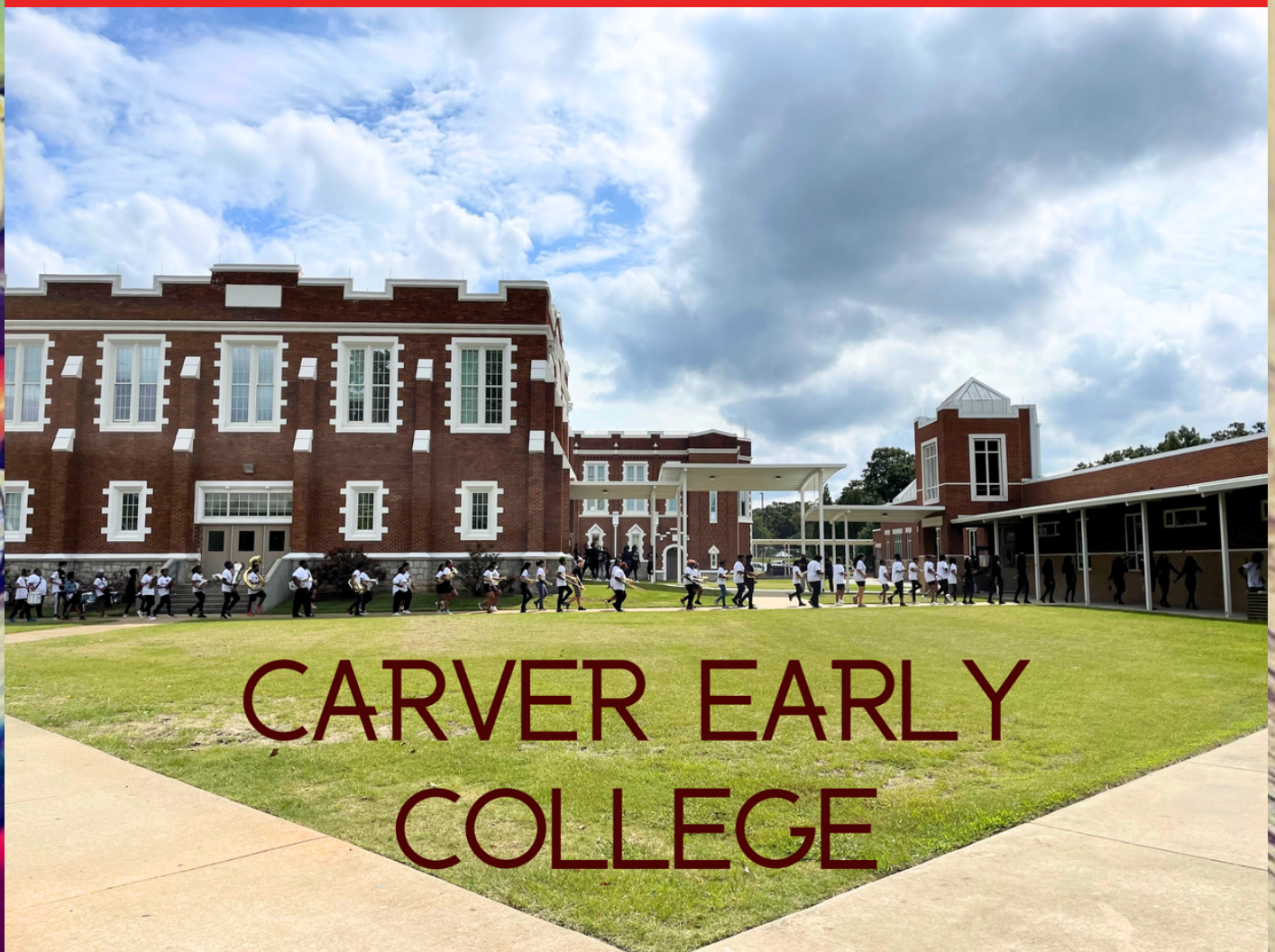

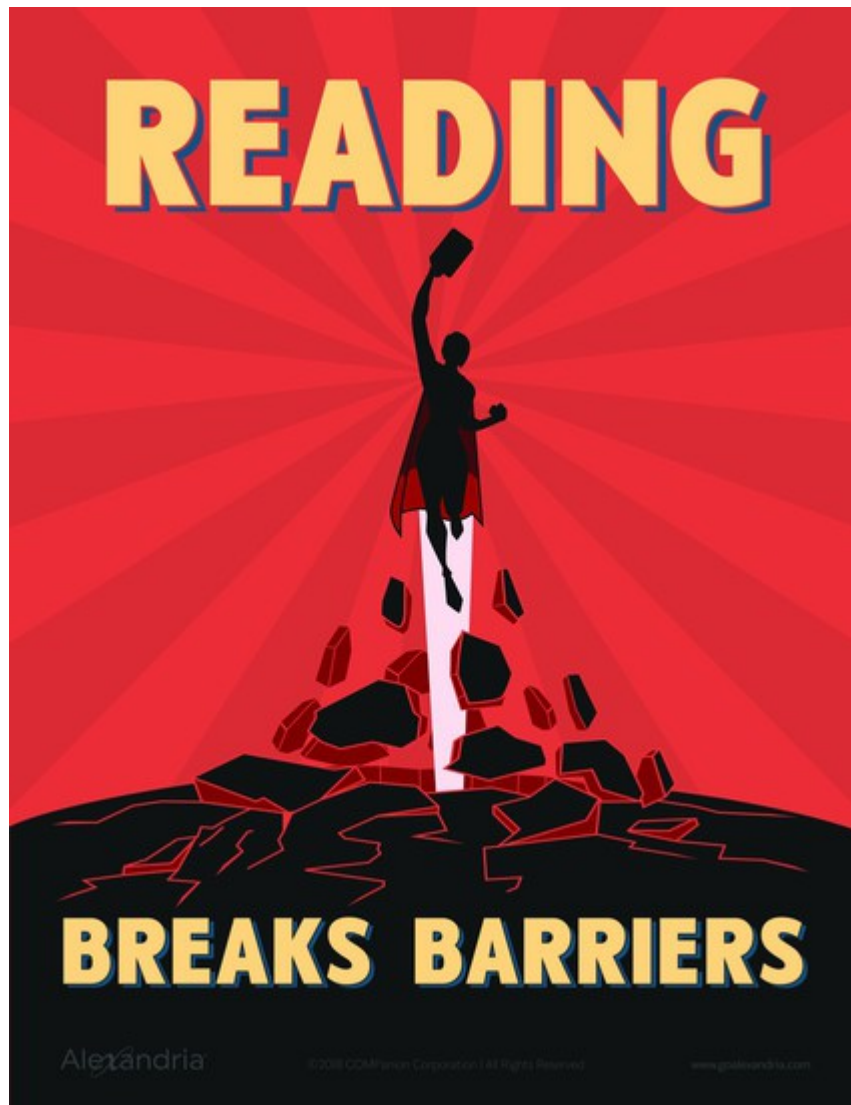

Go to Galileo, through My Backpack, and enter NoveList in the search box.

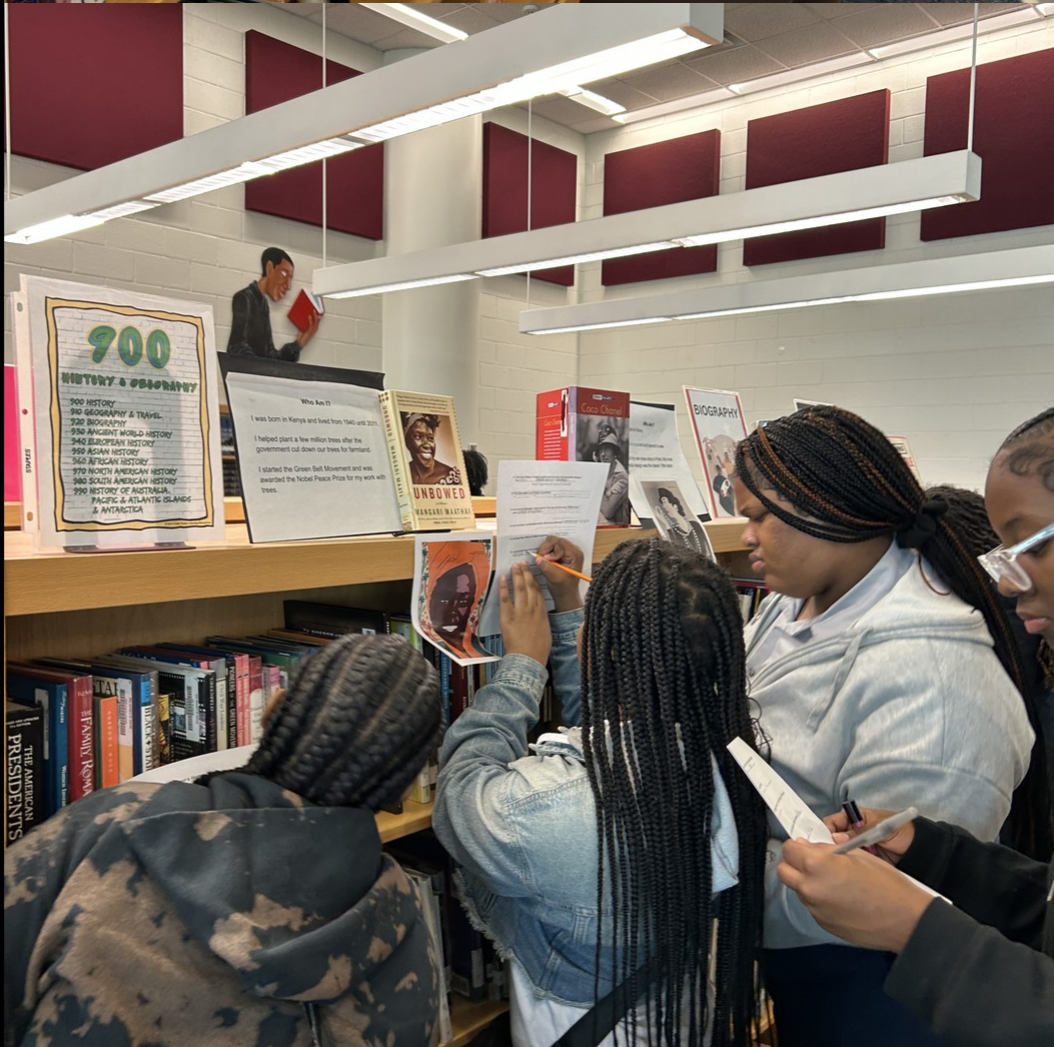
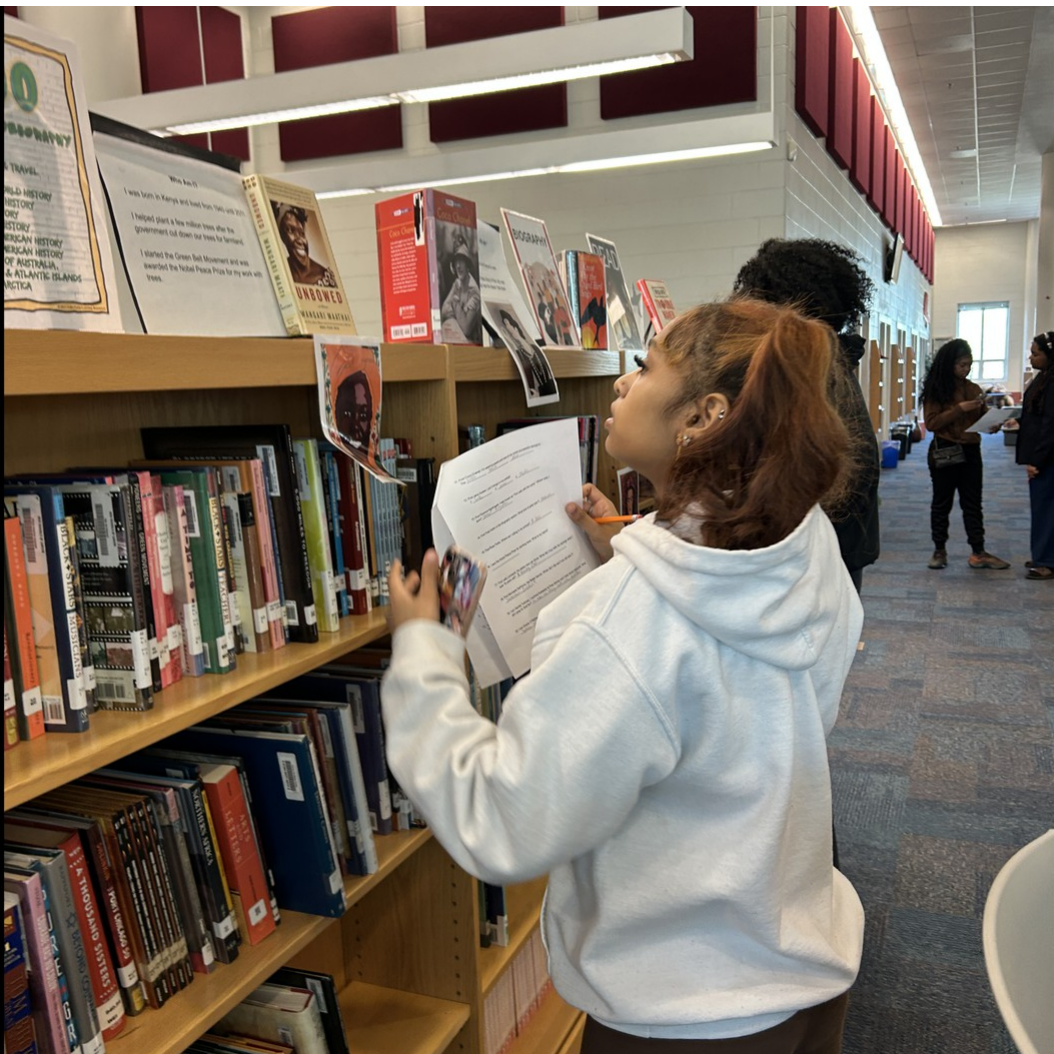


Women's History Month: Rebel Women Scavenger Hunt

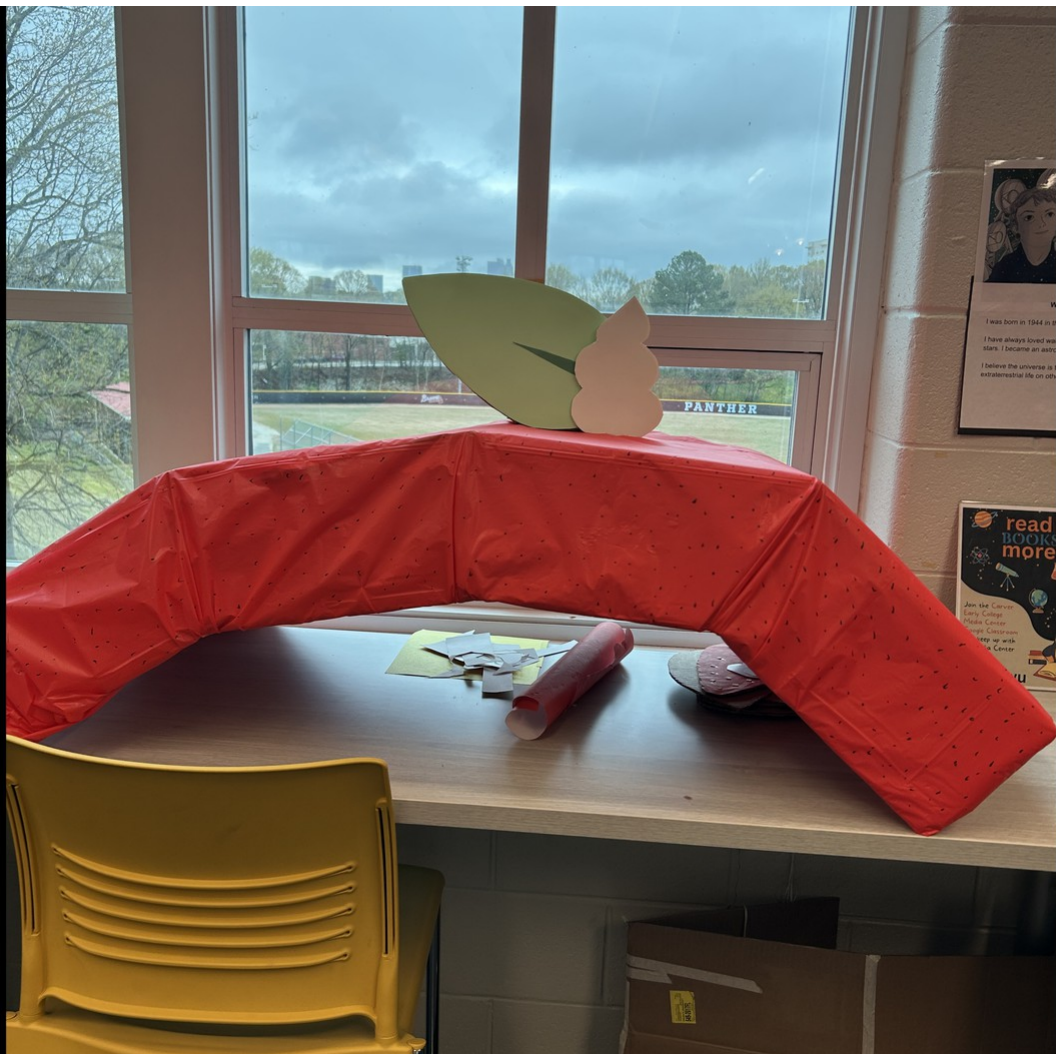


Japanese, Manga, Anime Club Annual Festival
