Back Up Alarms

Construction vehicles are equipped with back up alarms to alert nearby workers when a vehicle is in reverse. This is an important safety feature on a jobsite with workers and equipment working in the same area. A best practice for the workers on foot is to make eye contact with the equipment operator to ensure they are visible.
