#### "Scaffold Tagging System"

Scaffold tagging is meant to supplement the inspection portion of the scaffold safety program. Employees should only use scaffolds that have been completed and properly inspected, (identified by a "green tag"). A red or yellow tag signifies the scaffold as being incomplete and/or delayed.
