Vision: A student-centered school that empowers student development in equity, academics, social emotional learning, college and career readiness, and community outreach.

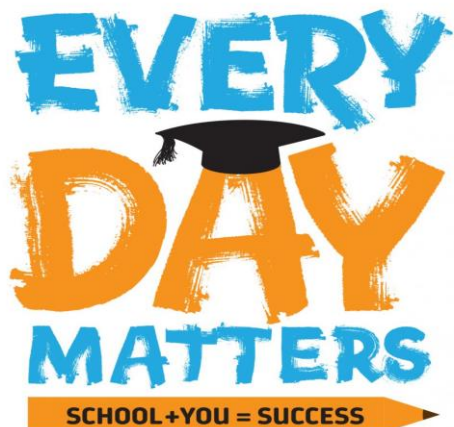

Ways the social worker can support you!

- Address resource needs: Food, uniforms, clothing, and economic aid
- Address student and parent concerns
- Assist in removing barriers to improve school attendance

Attendance Matters

- Attending school daily is a student's full time job. School should be a student's first priority
- Students can be chronically absent even if they only miss a day or two every few weeks
- Attendance is an important life skill that will help your child graduate from college and keep a job. Make school attendance a priority

What you can do

- Talk about the importance of showing up to school every day, make that the expectation
- Help your child maintain daily routines, such as finishing homework and getting a good night's sleep (i.e. 9 or 10pm bedtime or at least 8 hours of sleep a night)
- Try not to schedule dental and medical appointments during the school day
