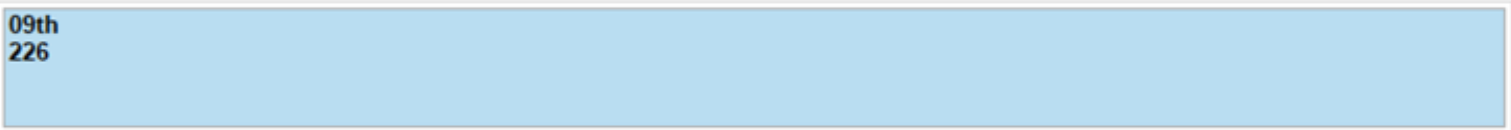


Cohort 2028 Breakdown



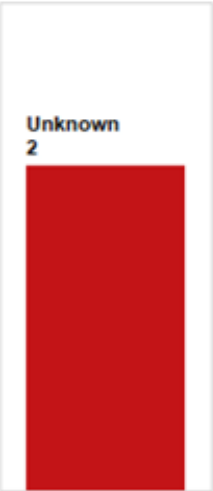

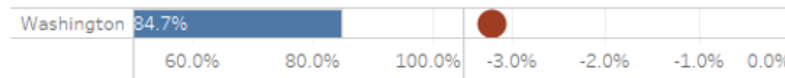

School ADA Attendance Comparison SY2024-2025

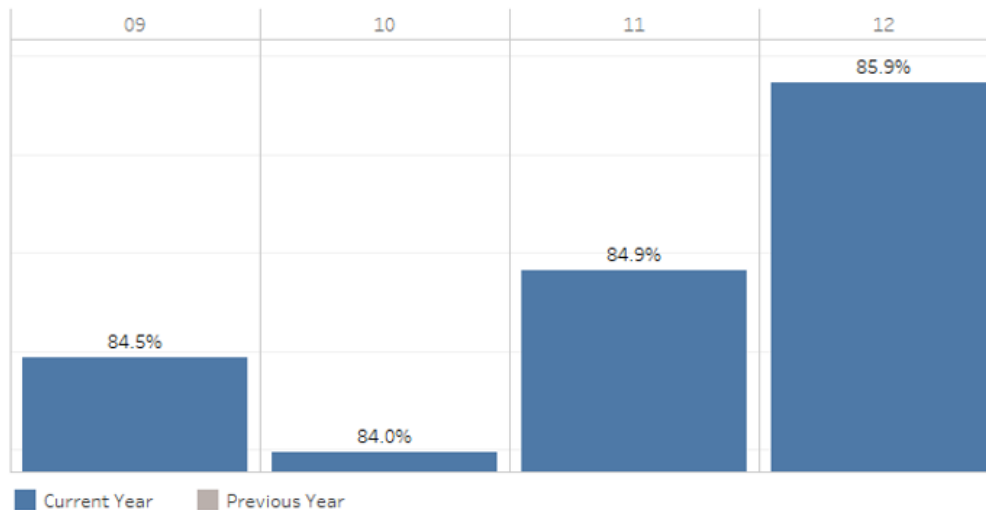

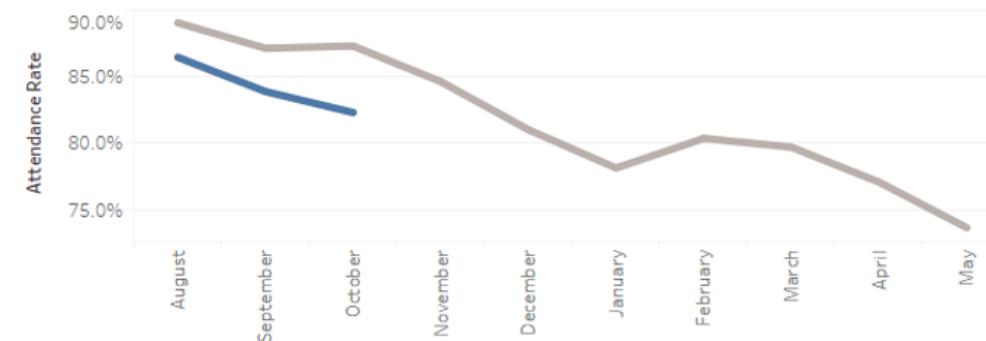

Grade Level ADA Support Plan

- ▶ Identify & respond to 9th subgroup pattern of chronic absences and skipping
 - ▶ Parent phone calls
 - ▶ Make home visits concerning students' absences if parents/guardians can't be reached by phone or email, a referral is made to the social worker.
 - ▶ Parent Attendance Meetings
 - ▶ Use APS Graphs to monitor skipping and absences

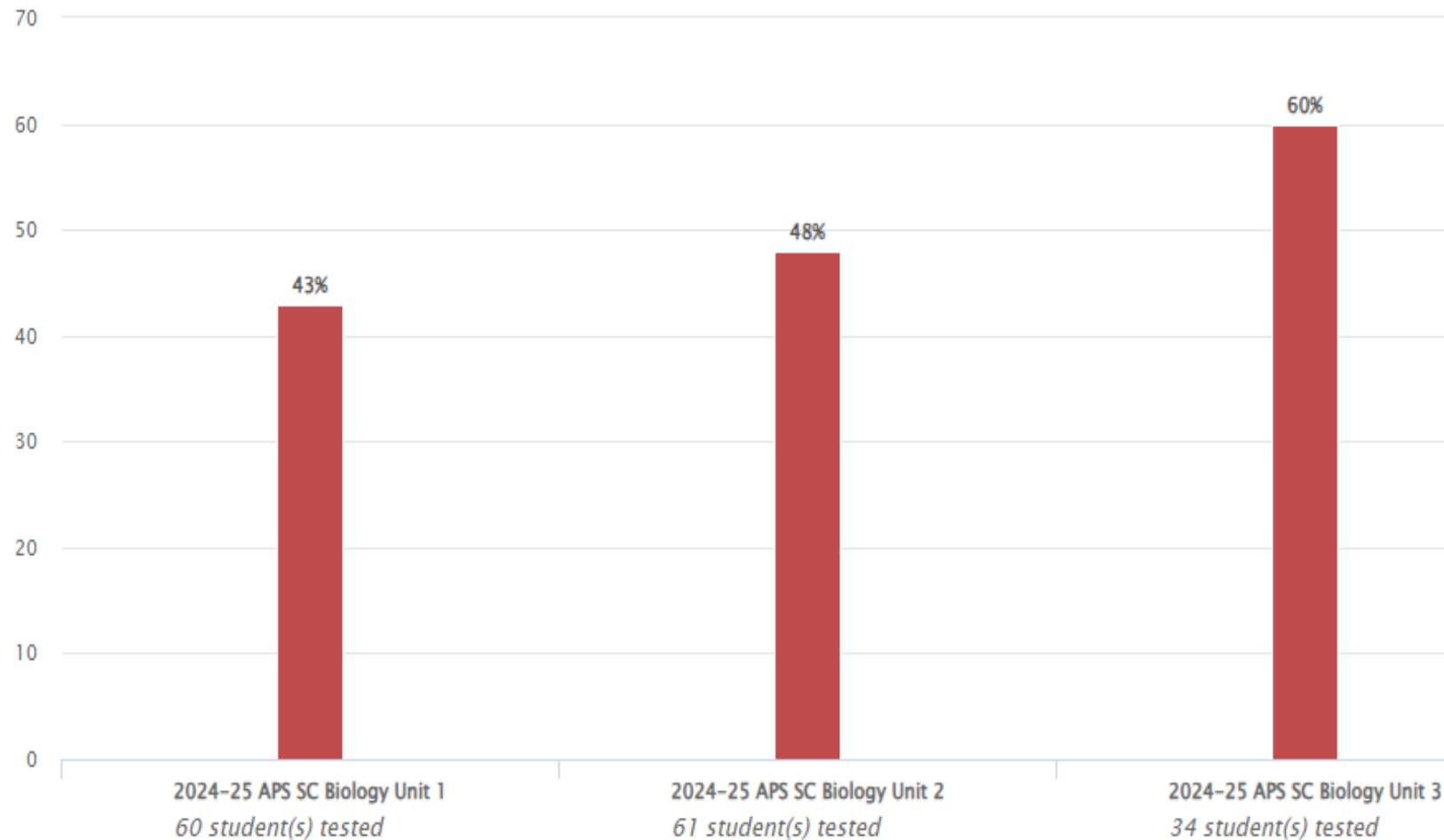

Assessment Comparison

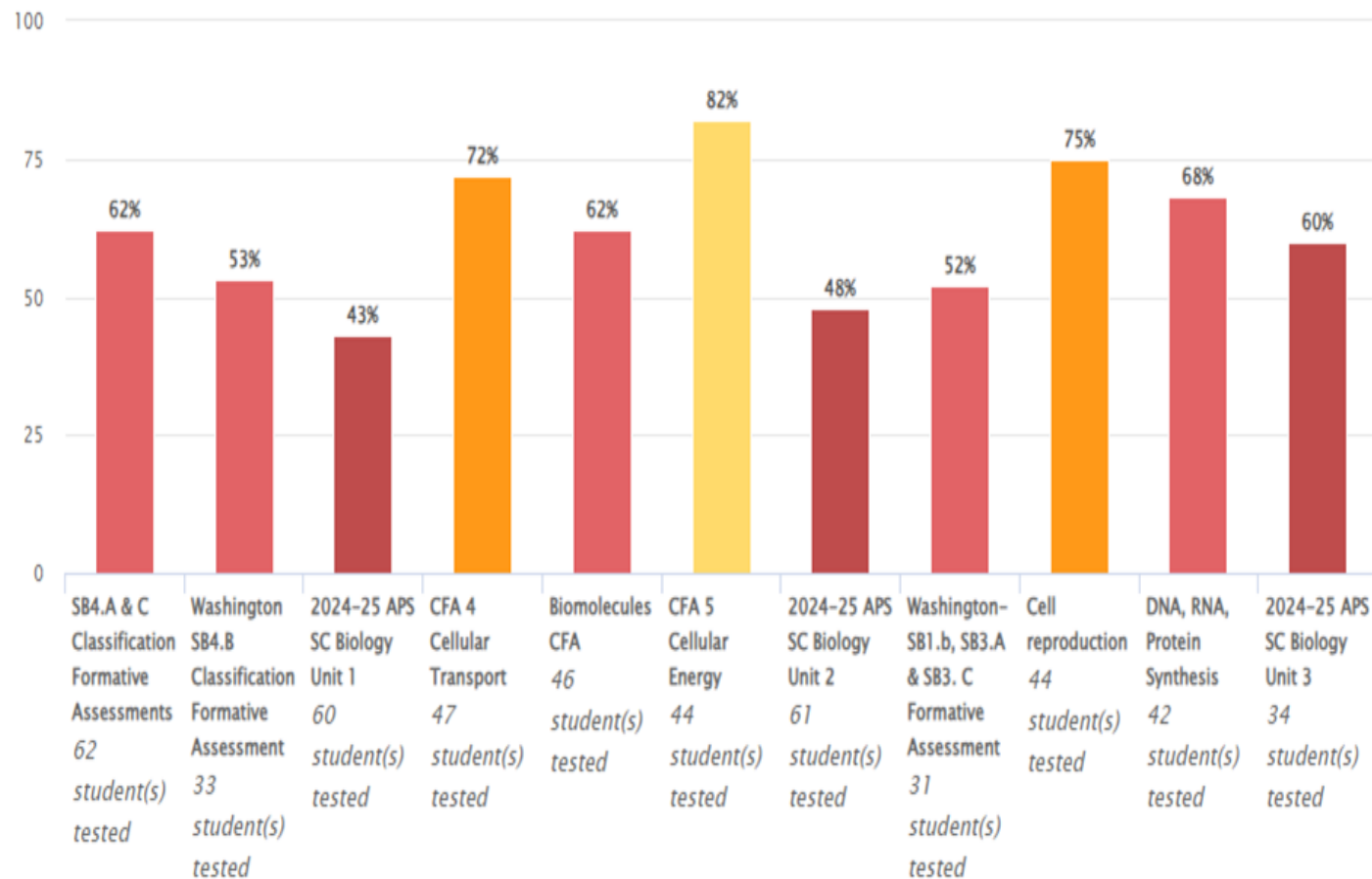
Average Score per assessment, ordered by administration date

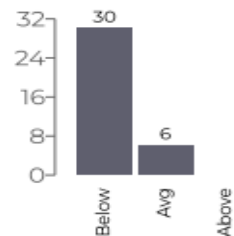

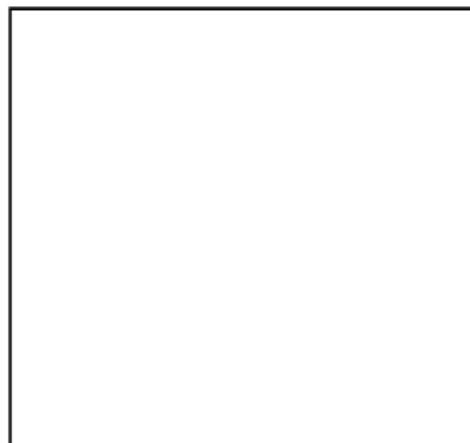

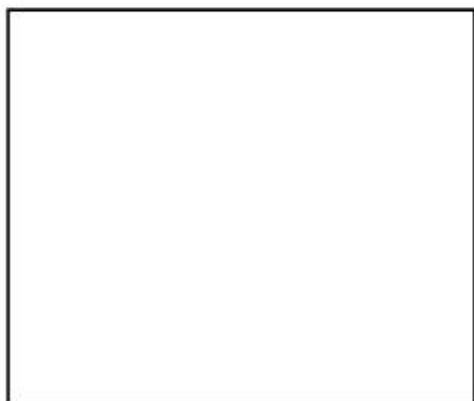

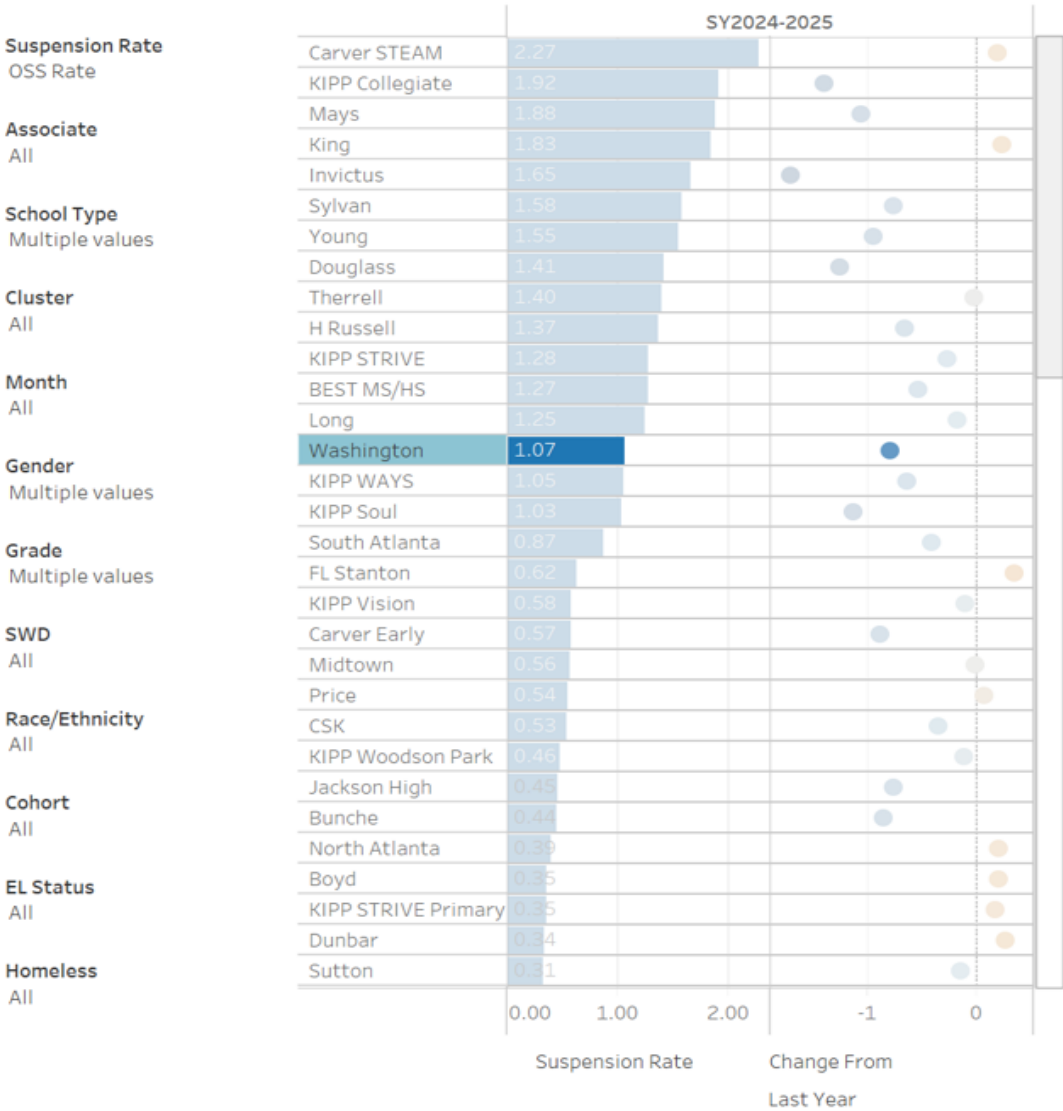

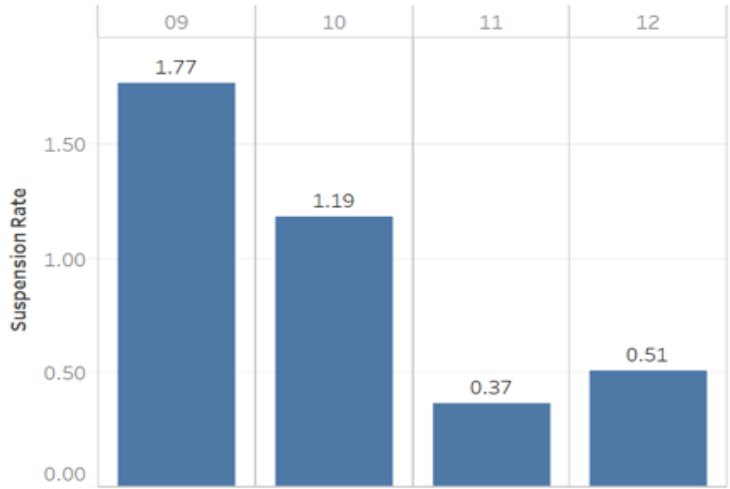

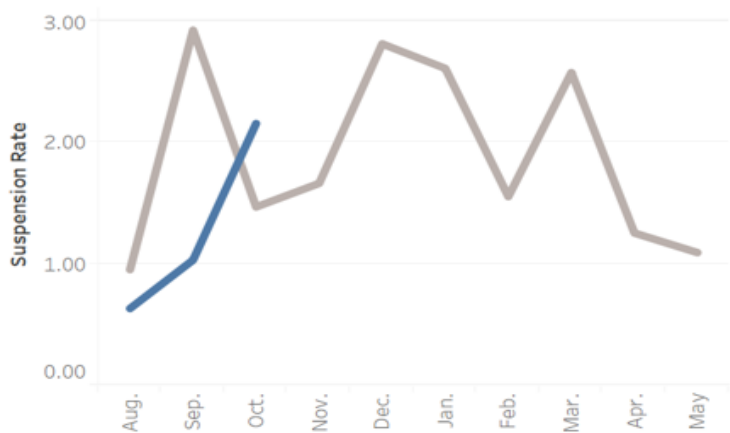


Suspension by Grade

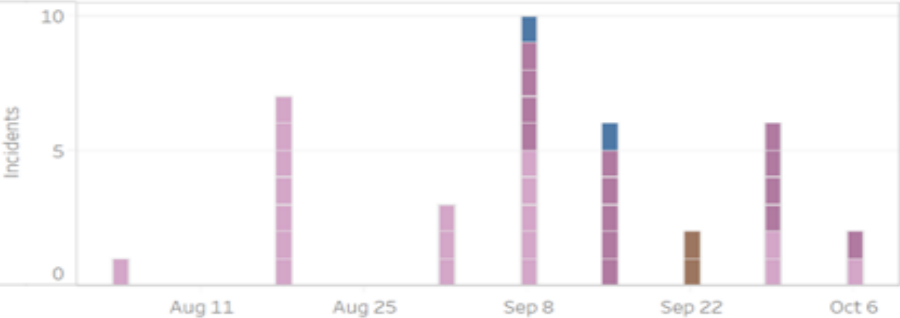

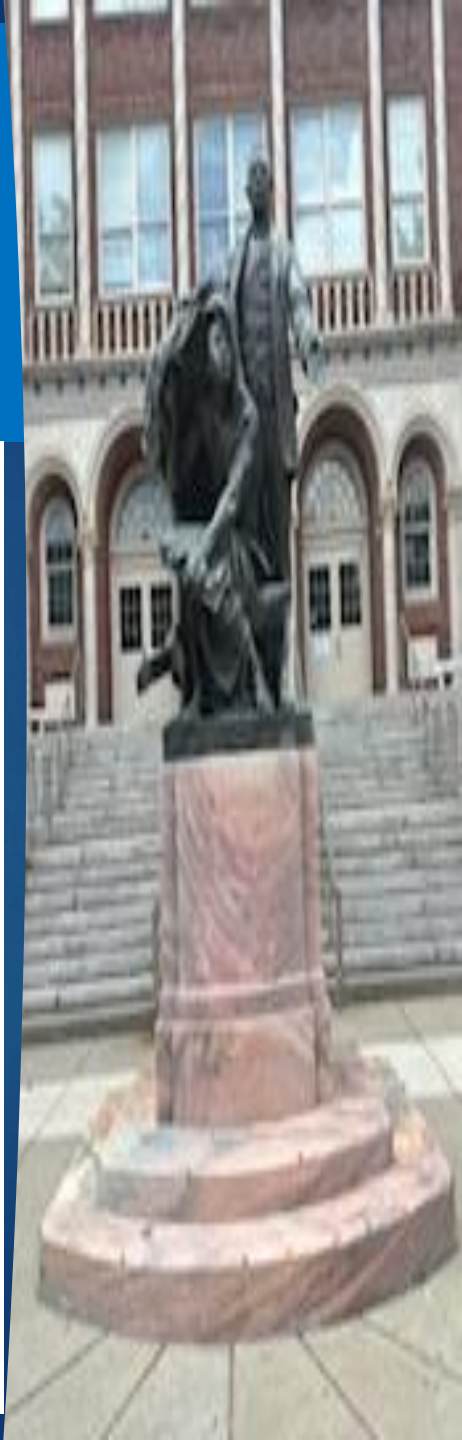

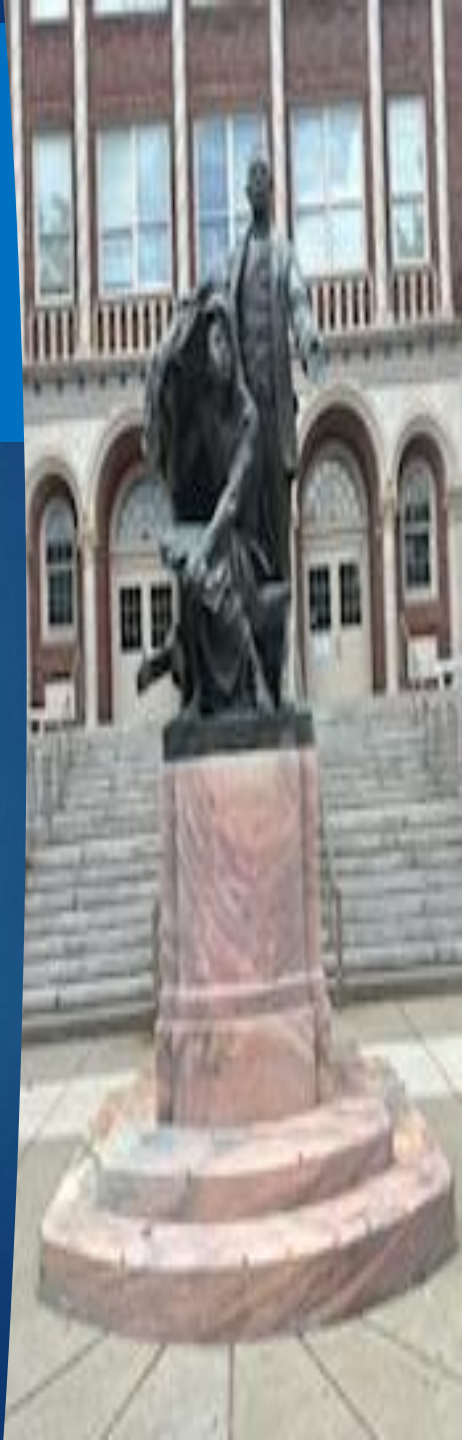
