### **Booker T. Washington High School Early College Application Requirements & Instructions**

We are so excited that you are interested in the Early College Program at Booker T. Washington High School. Completion of the student application is the first step to participating in this exciting high school experience.

The Early College Initiative provides students the opportunity to receive a high school diploma and an Associate of Science Degree or up to two years of transferable college credit, by taking a mixture of high school and college classes. Booker T. Washington High School currently partners with Atlanta Metropolitan State College, Atlanta Technical College, Clark Atlanta University, and Georgia State University to offer Early College access. Our goal is to provide underserved students with exposure and support for college as they simultaneously attain their high school diploma. Students will follow an accelerated college preparatory curriculum and must complete a college readiness course and participate in a summer institute. The Early College program provides comprehensive support for student participants which aids the development of the necessary academic and social habits needed for college.

Listed below are the minimum requirements for rising 9<sup>th</sup> grade students applying for the Early College program at Washington High School:

- Core Grade Point Average of 85 or higher
- Georgia Milestone Score of 515 or higher in English Language Arts and Mathematics
- Attendance Rate of 90% or better
- Discipline (solely based on APS student guidebook with a maximum of two level 1 or 2 offenses)

Students that meet the minimum requirements may apply. The application process will consist of the following:

- Student response questions
  - To be completed by applicant
- Academic Information Counselor Recommendation
   To be submitted by applicant's guidance counselor with the application in a sealed envelope or via email to tstembridge@apsk12.org.
