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We're launching a new health services program, and we want to make sure your family has access to these services all year long. Our school is hosting an Awareness Campaign to ensure 100% of families learn about our new student health services from Hazel Health. With parent or guardian permission, students can speak with a Hazel mental health professional right from school or at home. On-demand medical visits are currently available at home and at school!

Mental health services include:

- Scheduled short-term therapy visits: No waitlist for scheduled therapy sessions for coping with everything from anxiety, depression, and grief to peer and family relationships and bullying
- Care management to local resources: Referrals to local providers for continuity of care
- Coordination: Communication with families, local health providers, and school staff

On-demand physical health services include:

- Medical treatment: For stomach aches, headaches, sprained ankles, asthma concerns, and everything in between
- Medication: Hazel providers can send prescriptions to your pharmacy
- Coordination: With family physician and return to school communication

Please note, Hazel Health will not provide care related to sexual or reproductive health. In addition, Hazel cannot complete sports or annual physicals and cannot administer vaccinations.
